GAME PREVIEW DEFENSE DOMINATING FOR DIRTY DAWGS

Roanoke's defense has been lights out during the postseason, as the team has allowed just 1.8 goals per game during the President's Cup Playoffs. That includes just one goal from five-on-five play during the four-game active winning streak by the Dawgs, as the other four goals conceded came on opposing power plays. Austyn Roudebush had a 36-save shutout in Game Two against Huntsville to clinch the series sweep over the second-seeded Havoc, and currently leads all SPHL goalies in the playoffs with a .964 save percentage and a 1.20 goals against average. Sammy Bernard had previously led all goaltenders through Roanoke's first three games in those categories, with a .932 save clip and a 1.80 goals against average. The Dawgs will hope to continue their suffocating defensive play against the Rivermen.

BALANCED OFFENSE BLASTS OFF

The Dawgs have had nine different goalscorers during their four-game postseason winning streak, and 13 out of 16 skaters have registered at least one point. Nick Ford and Gehrett Sargis each have three goals, while Mac Jansen, Jeff Jones, and Brant Sherwood have tallied two goals a piece. When the offensive load is shared like this, Roanoke has proven to be a very difficult team to stop.

HISTORIC APPEARANCE FOR ROANOKE

This is the first time in franchise history that the Dawgs have made the President's Cup Final. Roanoke has seen two hockey franchises win hardwarde – the Virginia Lancers in the ACHL in 1987, and the Roanoke Valley rebels in the SHL in 1974.



SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

TERRIFIC TOP LINE

Peoria's top forward line has been the bread and butter all season for the Rivermen. League MVP Alec Baer recorded the league's first 80-point campaign in nearly a decade, and currently leads all players in the playoffs for both goals (five) and points (eight). Team captain Alec Hagaman has a league-high six assists in the playoffs, after a regular season in which he finished second in the league in points (71), only trailing Baer. Rookie winger Marcel Godbout also took home Rookie of the Year honors in the SPHL, after leading the league in goals with 33 in the regular season. Godbout netted four goals in the semifinal series alone against Quad City. The key for Roanoke's success definitely starts with shutting down this tough trio of forwards.

LORD OF THE BLUE LINE

Lordanthony Grissom had a strong start to his professional career with Peoria, tallying three goals, three assists, and a plus-13 in Peoria's last 12 regular season games of the season after signing out of the college ranks. He's taken it a step further in the playoffs, leading all rookies and defensemen in assists and points thanks to his two goals and five assists for the Rivermen.

BERRY BLOCKING OUT THE OPPOSITION

After Eric Levine was chased from the Peoria crease in a 6-4 Game Two loss to Pensacola in the first round, netminder Jack Berry has stolen the show. Berry has a .931 save percentage and a 2.14 goals against average in his five playoff appearances for Peoria, and is expected to be the Rivermen starter in the playoffs despite Levine's Second Team All-SPHL honors from the regular season.

PLENTY OF HISTORY, BAD BLOOD

Roanoke head coach Dan Bremner was a captain for Peoria head coach Jean Guy Trudel when Bremner played for Peoria, as recently as six years ago. Roanoke forward Jeff Jones also played with Peoria in his first SPHL season, while Peoria forward Cody Dion spent a couple of seasons with Roanoke (Dion is unavailable on IR). The history between these two teams had led to some testy matchups, as the last two games of the regular season series featured the two top games penalty minutes-wise in the SPHL this season (160 combined PIM on March 4, 168 combined PIM on March 6). Each of these teams has swept the other in postseason play before, with Peoria earning a 2-0 sweep in the 2018 playoffs, while Roanoke swept the Challenge Round 2-0 in 2019.

2018 President's Cup

DAWGS SWEPT BY TOP-SEEDED RIVERMEN

The first-ever playoff game in franchise history took place at the LaHaye Center in Lynchburg, as Roanoke fell 3-2 to Peoria. Colin Murray scored Roanoke's first playoff goal on the power play in the first period, and Steve Mele tied the score at 2-2 late in the second period. On less than a 48-hour turnaround, Roanoke dropped Game Two to the Rivermen 4-1. A Joe Sova goal early in the third period brought the score within one goal before two late Peoria scores clinched them the two-game sweep over the Dawgs.

DAWGS ACCEPT PEORIA CHALLENGE, THEN EDGED IN SEMIS BY BULLS

In the Challenge Round, top-seeded Peoria decided to play fifth-place Roanoke instead of the three lower-ranked teams that the Rivermen could have chosen from. The Dawgs responded to the lack of respect paid to them, and took down Peoria 4-3 at Berglund Center in Game One. Mac Jansen scored the first two goals for Roanoke, Colton Wolter tied the game in the third period, and Josh Nenadal netted the game-winning goal for the Dawgs with just 2:38 remaining in the game. Game Two saw Roanoke leap out to a 4-0 lead, and the Dawgs held on despite eight power play chances by the Rivermen to secure the series sweep with a 4-3 victory. Jordan Carvalho and Maxime Guyon each scored in the first period, and Guyon added the fourth goal after Cody Dion's tally in the second period. Jacob Caffrey made 41 saves in the series-deciding game. That took Roanoke to the semifinals to face off with Birmingham. The Dawgs dropped a tight Game One by a score of 4-3, despite a three-point performance by Mac Jansen and goals by Adrian Carbonara and Colin Murray. Roanoke handled business on the road in Game Two, keeping Birmingham off the board for the first 57 minutes of the game in a 4-1 win. Ben Bauer, Josh Nenadal, and Cam Bakker all scored, then Bakker added an empty net goal in the closing moments as added insurance. Game Three was a back-and-forth affair, with Birmingham scoring the first two goals, Roanoke answering with four consecutive scores, and then the Bulls closed it out with four unanswered goals of their own to win 6-4. Cody Dion and Mac Jansen each scored twice for the Dawgs, who were eliminated at Pelham Civic Complex.
