## GAME PREVIEW

### RIVALS SPLIT OPENING WEEKEND

Roanoke fired into the 2022-2023 season with a 4-2 win over their North Carolina-based rivals, the Fayetteville Marksmen, last Friday night at Berglund Center in front of 4,923 Dawgs fans. Mac Jansen, Nick DeVito, Josh Nenadal, and Travis Broughman all lit the lamp for the hosts to open the season 1-0. The Marksmen fought back with a 5-1 win on Saturday at Crown Coliseum, despite Roanoke outshooting Fayetteville 29-18. The two teams will face off 12 more times this season.

### BROUGHMAN ANNOUNCED AS TEAM PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Forward Travis Broughman was awarded the Paylocity Player of the Week award for his performance in Roanoke's first two games against Fayetteville. Broughman notched a goal and an assist in the Opening Night victory, and tallied a total of seven shots combined in the two contests. The Richmond native ranks tied for fourth among all SPHL rookies with two points through the first weekend of action.

### 22 DIFFERENT PLAYERS SEE ACTION

Each player besides Roanoke forward Jimmy Elser (unavailable for personal reasons) was able to suit up in at least one game for the Dawgs during Opening Weekend. 13 different Roanoke players suited up in both games, including winger Dominiks Marcinkevics who made his North American pro debut for the Dawgs on Friday night.

## SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

### NEW LOOK MAYHEM

After rehauling the roster last season en route to finishing 10th in the 11-team Southern Professional Hockey League, the Macon Mayhem returned just five players that appeared in a game for their squad last season for the 2022-2023 campaign. Caleb Cameron, Devin Brink, Kyle Soper, Bryan Etter, and Jamie Dorsey will try and lead the charge from the bottom of the standings back into contention for the Mayhem this year.

### CAPTAIN CAMERON HEADLINES THE HOSTS

A career forward for Macon since 2017, Caleb Cameron is back for Macon for his fifth season. With 187 games played, 51 goals, 66 assists, and 256 penalty minutes, the five-foot-ten skater is among the most respected players throughout the SPHL. Cameron already has a goal this season, scoring once in Macon's 5-3 defeat at Pensacola last Saturday.

### NIEDERT LANDS IN GEORGIA

After suiting up for over 40 teams throughout the AHL, ECHL, SPHL, FPHL, and other leagues, Macon appointed former minor league journeyman netminder Nick Niedert as their new head coach over this past summer. Niedert takes over for Zac DesJardins, who was only able to steer the Mayhem to a 10-40-6 record a season ago. Niedert was Vermilion County's interim head coach from November 2nd until the last week of the regular season in the 2021-2022 season, struggling with the newest expansion team to a 5-40-5 record at the helm of the Bobcats.

### PLENTY OF SPHL EXPERIENCE ADDED

CJ Hayes, Cody Karpinski, Wyatt Trumbley, David Nippard, and Tory McLean headline a group of seven players that have been picked up by Macon from other teams in the SPHL over the offseason. McLean was the team's first new signing of the summer, a big-bodied forward who suited up for Evansville and Huntsville last season. Hayes is now onto his fourth SPHL team after scoring seven goals in 29 games for Birmingham last season. Karpinski spent camp with the Rail Yard Dawgs last season before moving on to Pensacola last year, going 3-0-0 against Roanoke and 11-6-1 overall. Nippard is now with his fourth SPHL team, after notching 23 points in 52 games for Birmingham last season. Trumbley previously featured for Evansville and Fayetteville on the blue line between 2018-2020, and is back in the league now with the Mayhem. Tommy Munichiello, Connor Graham, and Troy Murray also saw action in more than a dozen SPHL games each last year for various teams.
