## GAME PREVIEW

### MATTY'S BACK, TELL A FRIEND!

For the first time in over a month, the Dawgs will have alternate captain Matt O'Dea back in the lineup tonight. The five-foot-eleven defenseman was leading all SPHL defensemen in goals (two) and points (eight), while also leading the entire SPHL in plus/minus with a plus-nine rating at the time of his placement on the injured reserve list back on November 17 (retroactive to November 12).

### THIRD LINE WEARS OUT MAYHEM

Roanoke's third line of Dom Marcinkevics, Josh Nenadal, and Dillon Radin used their high-energy style to break down the Mayhem in last night's 5-4 win over Macon. Nenadal scored twice, Marcinkevics notched three assists, and Radin tallied one goal and one assist. The tenacity of that line has been a massive reason for Roanoke's position in the standings up to this point, as the trio gives the Dawgs remarkable depth.

### ROANOKE CONTINUES SIX-GAME WIN STREAK

It's been a strong stretch lately for the entirety of the Roanoke squad, as the Dawgs have won six straight games and are on a seven-game point streak dating back to the Wednesday before Thanksgiving. During their last five wins, the Dawgs have outscored opponents 27-14, with Austyn Roudebush anchoring a strong defensive unit and the offense rotating between a balanced attack of producers. Nine different skaters notched a point last night for the Dawgs.

## SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

### MUNICIELLO HEADLINES MACON ATTACK

Tommy Munichello leads the Mayhem with 12 points entering tonight's game against the Dawgs. Munichello put Macon ahead briefly before Roanoke stormed back for a 6-2 win in its last trip to Macon Coliseum on October 29. Munichello has four goals and eight assists this year, with four of his apples coming on the man-advantage. Macon will skate tonight without leading goalscorer CJ Hayes, as well as Rhett Kingston, both of whom are suspended.

### RUSSELL, FAULKNER ANCHOR THE BLUE LINE

Rourke Russell and Timothy Faulkner are the two defensemen to watch tonight for Macon. Russell runs the point for the Mayhem power play unit, and has a team-best 10 assists overall thanks to his high-mark of six power play assists for the Mayhem. Faulkner has a whopping 68 penalty minutes this season, and has already fought Roanoke's Chris Vella back on November 11. It's not just physicality from Faulkner though – he has two goals and seven assists combined this season between his stints with Evansville and now Macon.

### BENSON, AUBRUN, OR GRAY?

It's been a tough year to be between the pipes for the Mayhem, with the team currently in last place. The tandem of Josh Benson and Tom Aubrun have played in all but one of Macon's games this season. Their numbers are almost identical, with both of them owning a .884 save percentage and Benson's 3.98 goals against average barely edging out Aubrun at 4.01 GAA. The recent arrival of Cam Gray, who most recently played with the ECHL's Indy Fuel (this season) and Fort Wayne Komets (last spring) could be a huge boost. Gray was an NCAA-DIII national champion at Adrian, going 23-0-0 last season. Gray saw his first SPHL action in relief of Aubrun in Macon's loss last night.

### SECOND-TO-LAST MEETING BETWEEN ROANOKE AND MACON

In a game that appeared to be all Dawgs early on, Macon's chippiness and physicality kept the game close back on November 11 for awhile. Roanoke ended up pulling away for a 5-2 win, as Billy Vizzo tallied two goals, Travis Broughman added one goal and two assists, and CJ Stubbs notched a goal and an assist for the Dawgs. Macon had 50 penalty minutes to Roanoke's 34, and two goals in less than two minutes by the Mayhem brought the game to 3-2 exactly halfway through the contest. The Dawgs were able to take advantage of the Macon penalties, scoring twice on their six power play chances that night.
