GAME PREVIEW

MAKE WAY FOR MARTY!

After taking the first part of the season away from the sport, defenseman Bryce Martin has signed back with the Rail Yard Dawgs, and made his season debut last night. Martin has suited up in 36 regular season games since 2019 for Roanoke, and was a part of the President's Cup Final run for the Dawgs last season.

JANNY SETS NEW RECORD

Captain Mac Jansen broke the all-time franchise record for career points with his first of two assists on Thursday night. He now has 124 career points in a Roanoke sweater, with 54 goals and 70 assists as a Rail Yard Dawg. He leads the team with 23 points (six goals, 17 assists) this year.

AUBRUN DEBUT, PIMS GALORE LAST NIGHT IN LOSS

Tom Aubrun had a strong first start for Roanoke after he was acquired from Macon on Thursday, stopping 29-of-31 shots. However, 137 combined penalty minutes and eight empty power plays for the Dawgs highlighted an undisciplined game by both Roanoke and Quad City, and the Storm took the 3-1 victory. The Dawgs have now dropped two out of their last three after reeling off a nine-game winning streak.

VELLA OPENS HIS SEASON SCORESHEET

Chris Vella scored his first goal of the year last night for the Dawgs on a beautiful shot from the left wing.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

BALANCED ATTACK HEADLINES HAVOC

Nine different Huntsville skaters have tallied double digit points this season, with six of them scoring six or more goals up to this point. Rob Darrar is having a career year, with eight goals and 18 assists for a team-best 26 points, including three power play goals. With other returning studs like Sy Nutkevich, Tyler Piacentini, and Jacob Barber, there are plenty of threats for the Huntsville attack.

MARTINSEN MAKES MOST OF CHANCES

Rookie forward Austin Martinsen has been a massive addition for the Havoc. He has a team-high 12 goals, tied for sixth-most in the league, on just 36 shots. His 33.3 percent shooting clip is second-best in the entire SPHL, and he's added seven assists as well. His plus-11 rating also leads the team. The Dawgs will have to keep him in check in tonight's game.

GREAT GOALTENDING

Despite losing Max Milosek to the ECHL and having Hunter Vorva bounce up and down to the Coast this season, the Havoc have established a new rookie netminding tandem that has performed very well so far this year. Nick Latinovich leads the way with a 10-5-1 record in 16 starts, with a .918 save clip and a 2.74 goals against average. His 10 wins trail only Roanoke's Austyn Roudebush throughout the league. Backup Mike Robinson is 2-1-0 in four starts, with a .913 save percentage. Seeing as Vorva has only played in three games for Huntsville with a .865 save clip, the Havoc may have found their new prolific pair in between the pipes.

LAST MEETING BETWEEN ROANOKE AND HUNTSVILLE

Roanoke and Huntsville met once already this season, as the Havoc won 2-1 on the strength of an incredible game by Latinovich back on November 18. Prior to last night, it had been the last game that Roanoke had rested Austyn Roudebush. CJ Stubbs scored Roanoke's lone goal to match Kyle Clarke's early score for Huntsville, but it was a goal off the opening third period faceoff by Tyler Piacentini that proved to be the difference after Sean Leonard simply slipped, giving the Huntsville captain a clean look on net. Latinovich stopped 29-of-30 shots faced, including 14 in the final frame. That win by Huntsville and Roanoke's loss last night to Quad City are the only two games this season in which the Dawgs have been outshot by their opponent.
