GAME PREVIEW EVANSVILLE SWEPT, FINALS REMATCH NEXT

Roanoke swept through its first round President's Cup Playoffs matchup with Evansville, winning 4-2 on the road and 4-0 at home to eliminate the Thunderbolts. 11 different Dawgs skaters recorded at least one point during the two Roanoke wins, and the Dawgs only conceded three power play chances to Evansville over the two games. Now, Roanoke rematches the Peoria Rivermen, who beat the Dawgs three-games-to-one in the 2022 President's Cup Finals last spring.

ROUDEBUSH ROLLS BY BOLTS IN SHUTOUT FASHION

Dawgs goalie Austyn Roudebush was incredible in the first round for Roanoke, stopping 21-of-23 shots in the Game One win before unveiling a 32-save shutout in Game Two against Evansville. Roudebush led the SPHL in wins (24) during the regular season, and is right near the top of SPHL goalie stats for the playoffs entering into the semifinal matchup against Peoria.

DAWGS OFFENSE CLICKING LATELY

The offensive output for the Dawgs was strong in the opening round, with four goals scored each game, and it's been strong for the last eight games for the Dawgs. Roanoke has scored four or more goals in seven out of its last eight contests, and scored three goals in a victory in the outlying game. That includes nine goals in the last six games for Gehrett Sargis. Roanoke has tallied 37 goals over the eight-game span.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

FAMILIAR FACES LEAD RIVERMEN

A veteran-laiden squad took Peoria to the top of the regular season standings this year following its President's Cup title last season, and as many as 11 Rivermen on their active playoff roster were a part of the team that beat Roanoke for the championship last season. That includes captain Alec Hagaman, a Second Team All-SPHL selection in the regular season, who had a goal in each of Peoria's first round wins against Pensacola. It also includes 2021-22 SPHL MVP Alec Baer, All-SPHL First Team defenseman Nick Neville, and J.M. Piotrowski, scorer of Peoria's Game 4 OT winner against the Dawgs last season that gave the Rivermen the cup, among others.

INJURY SITUATION COULD IMPACT PEORIA

Peoria is expected to get back 2021-22 SPHL Rookie of the Year Marcel Godbout from the injured reserve list, but this season's SPHL Defenseman of the Year Zach Wilkie is still not expected to be available in this series for Peoria. Wilkie led all blue-liners in the regular season in goals (13), points (43), and plus/minus (+42) before sustaining an injury against Roanoke back on April 1 at Berglund Center. Peoria only have five other listed defenseman on its playoff roster, leaving the Rivermen fairly short on the backend from a standpoint of options.

BERRY TAKES OVER FOR LEVINE

After Peoria struggled a bit to figure out which goaltender would be its top choice entering the postseason, 2022 President's Cup Playoffs MVP Jack Berry has asserted himself as 'the guy' for the Rivermen. Berry stopped 41-of-44 shots faced in Peoria's first round sweep of Pensacola, with a 1.50 GAA and .932 save percentage. Berry had also been named the league's final Player of the Week in the regular season, and Berry has won seven consecutive starts for Peoria. The last time he allowed more than two goals in a game was in Peoria's 6-4 win over Roanoke back on April 1.

LAST MEETING BETWEEN ROANOKE AND PEORIA

Roanoke and Peoria only met twice this season, as the 2022 Finals rematch had to wait until March 31 and April 1 to commence. The Dawgs won 4-2 on the first night, riding two goals by Jordan Xavier in his pro debut, 29 saves by Roudebush, and goals by Billy Vizzo and Jason Lavallée to the victory. Peoria made sure the weekend was split the next night, with goals by six different goalscorers, including power play tallies by Hagaman and Joseph Widmar, spoiling any potential Roanoke comeback in a 6-4 win by the Rivermen.

PLAYOFF SERIES HISTORY

2018 President's Cup DAWGS SWEPT BY TOP-SEEDED RIVERMEN

The first-ever playoff game in franchise history took place at the LaHaye Center in Lynchburg, as Roanoke fell 3-2 to Peoria. On less than a 48-hour turnaround, Roanoke dropped Game Two to the Rivermen 4-1.

DAWGS ACCEPT PEORIA CHALLENGE, THEN EDGED IN SEMIS BY BULLS

In the Challenge Round, top-seeded Peoria decided to play fifth-place Roanoke instead of the three lower-ranked teams that the Rivermen could have chosen from. The Dawgs responded to the lack of respect paid to them, and took down Peoria 4-3 at Berglund Center in Game One. Game Two saw Roanoke leap out to a 4-0 lead, and the Dawgs held on despite eight power play chances by the Rivermen to secure the series sweep with a 4-3 victory. That took Roanoke to the semifinals to face off with Birmingham. The Dawgs dropped a tight Game One by a score of 4-3. Roanoke handled business on the road in Game Two, keeping Birmingham off the board for the first 57 minutes of the game in a 4-1 win. Game Three was a back-and-forth affair, with Birmingham scoring the first two goals, Roanoke answering with four consecutive scores, and then the Bulls closed it out with four unanswered goals of their own to win 6-4.

DIRTY DAWGS MAKE CINDERELLA RUN, LOSE IN FIRST FINALS APPEARANCE

Roanoke entered the postseason in 2022 as the eighth and final seed to make the SPHL field. Taking on a Knoxville team that set a new league record for wins on the year, Roanoke bounced back from a 4-1 Game One loss at Knoxville to tie the series in a 5-1 Game Two blowout at Berglund Center. On Easter Sunday, the Dawgs scored twice in the first five minutes, and held on for a 3-1 win that upset the top-seeded Ice Bears. Roanoke matched up with two-seed Huntsville in the semifinals, and stormed past the Havoc 5-3 in Game One. A 36-save shutout by Austyn Roudebush in Game Two led Roanoke to a 2-0 win, and a series sweep. In the Finals against the Peoria Rivermen, the Dawgs fell in the closing moments of Game One 3-2 before getting thumped 7-3 in Game Two. Roanoke extended the series with a 4-3 Game Three win at home, but Peoria won the title 3-2 in overtime in Game Four.


