## GAME PREVIEW

### DAWGS FINALLY AVENGE FINALS LOSS AGAINST RIVERMEN

In the first meeting between the two teams since Peoria won the 2022 President's Cup at Berglund Center last May, the Rail Yard Dawgs took down the first-place Rivermen 4-2 on Friday night. The Dawgs are now on a five-game point streak, winning in four of those contests.

### X-CEPTIONAL DEBUT FOR XAVIER

Jordan Xavier's pro debut couldn't have gone any better last night for Roanoke, as the rookie forward netted two goals in the 4-2 win by the Dawgs. Xavier tallied his first on a long-rane blast from the left wing circle in the first period to open the scoring, then sealed the deal on the Roanoke victory by tallying an empty-net goal in the closing moments of the game. The five-foot-ten winger had joined the Dawgs this past week on a PTO contract after finishing his college career for his hometown college, the University of Calgary out in Alberta.

### ROUDEBUSH WRECKS ANOTHER GAME IN NET

Roanoke's Austyn Roudebush was dominant once again between the pipes for the Dawgs, coming up huge as he slowed down Peoria's attack with 29 saves on 31 shots faced. Roudebush also added the secondary assist on Xavier's empty-net goal after reviewing the video of the score. The six-foot-three netminder leads the SPHL in wins with 23, and has played the most minutes in the league by more than 200.

## SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

### DEEP PEORIA OFFENSE ROLLS IN

Led as always by captain Alec Hagaman, the Rivermen attack has seven active players with 30 or more points this season. Hagaman leads the team in assists (35) and points (55), while also accumulating 194 penalty minutes. Next up is JM Piotrowski, with a team-best 20 goals and 48 points on the year. Reigning league MVP Alec Baer has 47 points in 38 games played, and last year's breakout playoff star Jordan Ernst has 18 goals this season. When multiple cogs to this Peoria machine are working properly, it can be a very difficult offense to stop.

### STAUNCH DEFENSE A KEY FOR THE RIVERMEN

The real strength of Peoria has been the defense, as the Rivermen lead the league in goals allowed, shots on goal allowed, and penalty kill percentage this season. Zach Wilkie had a league-best plus-40 rating this season, 13 better than anybody else in the SPHL, while also adding 13 goals and 30 assists from the blue line. Nick Neville is plus-22 himself, and has 36 points on the year. Goaltender Eric Levine has been among the league's best, ranking second in the SPHL for goals against average (2.30), sixth for save percentage (.915), fourth for wins (17), and first in shutouts with five. Add in last year's Playoff MVP Jack Berry as Peoria's other goaltending option, and the Rivermen are one of the league's toughest teams to break down.

### RIVERMEN SLUMPING SLIGHTLY

After starting the season 30-9-2 and being in first place for most of the campaign, Peoria went 3-4-2 from February 23 to March 24. That has brought Birmingham up on to the heels of the Rivermen for the William B. Coffey Trophy as the league's regular season champion heading into the last two weeks. Peoria did bounce back to thrash Quad City last Saturday and Sunday by a combined score of 14-3, but the Dawgs will aim for the sweep tonight after shutting down Peoria 4-2 last night in Roanoke.

### LAST MEETING BETWEEN ROANOKE AND PEORIA

Roanoke lost the regular season series 1-4-0 to the Rivermen last season before the two teams met in the President's Cup Final. The Rivermen won the series three games to one, clinching the title at Berglund Center in a 3-2 overtime win thanks to the tip goal of JM Piotrowski. This will be the first meeting between the two teams this year. Peoria has 11 players on its active roster from that team that won the title in Roanoke, while the Dawgs have 10 active players available who were in that championship series.
