GAME PREVIEW

SERIES TIED, HOME ICE FLIPPED ENTERING GAME THREE

The Dawgs and the Bulls split the first two games in Alabama, condensing this best-of-five series down to a best-of-three with two of the potential games taking place in Roanoke. The Dawgs are 2-0 at home in the postseason, and 20-8-2 at Berglund Center overall this year. After winning Game One 4-2, the Dawgs were shut out in Game Two. Prior to the Game Two loss, the Dawgs had scored 52 goals in a 12-game span, scoring more than three goals in each game during that stretch and four-plus in nine of the 12 games.

DEFENSE, ROUDEBUSH STILL TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS

2027 DREGIDENT'S CUR DI AVOEES

Roanoke has relied on its defense and the goaltending of Austyn Roudebush as its strength all season long, and it's been no different in the President's Cup Playoffs. Roudebush has saved 201 of the 216 shots he's faced in seven postseason games, with a .931 save percentage for the Dawgs. Roanoke's penalty kill has been great lately also, with just two power play goals allowed on 12 power plays against, including four major penalty kills since Game Three of the semifinals against Peoria.

ALVO BACK IN THE LINEUP

After missing Game Two of the Final due to a one-game suspension, defenseman Stephen Alvo returns tonight for Roanoke. Alvo's six assists and seven points are tied for the most among all SPHL blue-liners in the postseason with Birmingham's Artur Terchiyev.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

HIGH-FLYING OFFENSE LEADS BULLS

The offensive firepower stands out when you look up and down the Birmingham roster. In the regular season, ten different players had double digit goals, nine of them are still on the active roster. Also, 13 players had 25 or more points, and ten of them remain on the active roster. Michael Gillespie, Carson Rose, Jake Pappalardo, Mike Davis, and Jordan Martin are the leaders for this group. Gillespie led the team with 27 goals and 60 points in the regular season, Rose had 30 points in 27 games, Pappalardo had 20 goals and is one of the stronger centers on the draw in the league, the captain Davis had 23 goals, and Martin notched 35 points in 41 games. Four different players have three or more goals in the President's Cup Playoffs so far, and six different guys have notched at least five points in the postseason. The Dawgs held Birmingham to just 55 shots on goal and four goals combined in the first two games of the series.

OVERTIME TIMES THREE

Birmingham has gone to overtime in three of its six President's Cup Playoffs games so far, beating Huntsville in Game One of the semifinals but falling in the extra period in Game One of the first round at Fayetteville and in Game Two of the semis at Huntsville. The Bulls won five of their nine post-regulation games during the regular season, while the Dawgs won just two out of seven of those games themselves. Additionally, Roanoke won just once in 11 post-regulation games during the 2021-2022 season. With how tight this matchup seems to be on paper, that will be a factor to watch in this series.

LOTZ TAKES OVER FOR STEWART

In the regular season, goaltenders Austin Lotz and Hayden Stewart split the goaltending duties for the Bulls, with Lotz handling the number one duties with 33 appearances to Stewart's 22. Lotz was tied with Roanoke's Austyn Roudebush for the most wins in the league with 24, and tallied a 2.73 goals against average and a .909 save clip. Stewart had a .905 save clip and a 2.71 goals against average, while notching a record of 12-8-1. However, Stewart became the hot hand entering the postseason, starting Birmingham's Game Two and Game Three in the first round. Stewart allowed just two goals on 61 shots faced in 120 minutes, including a shutout win in Game Two against Fayetteville. Then Stewart got banged up, and Lotz has come back in to get the Bulls to the Final. Lotz is 3-2 in the postseason, with a .924 save percentage and a 1.90 goals against average. Stewart was healthy enough to start Game One, but stopped just 19-of-23 shots faced in Birmingham's 4-2 loss to Roanoke. Lotz recorded a 33-save shutout in Game Two, asserting himself as the go-to goalie for the Bulls entering Game Three in Roanoke.

PLAYOFF SERIES HISTORY

2018 President's Cup DAWGS SWEPT BY TOP-SEEDED RIVERMEN

The first-ever playoff game in franchise history took place at the LaHaye Center in Lynchburg, as Roanoke fell 3-2 to Peoria. On less than a 48-hour turnaround, Roanoke dropped Game Two to the Rivermen 4-1.

DAWGS ACCEPT PEORIA CHALLENGE, THEN EDGED IN SEMIS BY BULLS

In the Challenge Round, top-seeded Peoria decided to play fifth-place Roanoke instead of the three lower-ranked teams that the Rivermen could have chosen from. The Dawgs responded to the lack of respect paid to them, and took down Peoria 4-3 at Berglund Center in Game One. Game Two saw Roanoke leap out to a 4-0 lead, and the Dawgs held on despite eight power play chances by the Rivermen to secure the series sweep with a 4-3 victory. That took Roanoke to the semifinals to face off with Birmingham. The Dawgs dropped a tight Game One by a score of 4-3. Roanoke handled business on the road in Game Two, keeping Birmingham off the board for the first 57 minutes of the game in a 4-1 win. Game Three was a back-and-forth affair, with Birmingham scoring the first two goals, Roanoke answering with four consecutive scores, and then the Bulls closed it out with four unanswered goals of their own to win 6-4.

DIRTY DAWGS MAKE CINDERELLA RUN, LOSE IN FIRST FINALS APPEARANCE

Roanoke entered the postseason in 2022 as the eighth and final seed to make the SPHL field. Taking on a Knoxville team that set a new league record for wins on the year, Roanoke bounced back from a 4-1 Game One loss at Knoxville to tie the series in a 5-1 Game Two blowout at Berglund Center. On Easter Sunday, the Dawgs scored twice in the first five minutes, and held on for a 3-1 win that upset the top-seeded Ice Bears. Roanoke matched up with two-seed Huntsville in the semifinals, and stormed past the Havoc 5-3 in Game One. A 36-save shutout by Austyn Roudebush in Game Two led Roanoke to a 2-0 win, and a series sweep. In the Finals against the Peoria Rivermen, the Dawgs fell in the closing moments of Game One 3-2 before getting thumped 7-3 in Game Two. Roanoke extended the series with a 4-3 Game Three win at home, but Peoria won the title 3-2 in overtime in Game Four.


