DAWGS NEWS AND NOTES

ROANOKE HOPES TO RUN IT BACK

ROANOKE ENTERED ITS FIRST ROUND SERIES WITH QUAD CITY AS THE THREE SEED, STARTING ON THE ROAD IN GAME ONE WITH A 3-2 OT LOSS BEFORE WINNING 3-2 AT HOME ON FRIDAY. IN THE LAST TWO PLAYOFF RUNS. ROANOKE HAD GONE 12-6 EN ROUTE TO TWO APPERANCES IN THE FINAL AND ONE PRESIDENT'S CUP TITLE. TONIGHT IS AN ELIMINATION GAME FOR BOTH TEAMS, WITH THE WINNER ADVANCING TO THE SEMIFINALS.

DAWGS CLUTCH IT OUT IN GAME TWO

THE DAWGS HAD THEIR BACKS AGAINST THE WALL LAST NIGHT. FACING ELIMINATION WITH IF THEY LOST TO THE STORM. AN EARLY GOAL BY QUAD CITY'S MIKE MORAN WAS ANSWERED BY A POWER PLAY BLAST BY BRENDAN PEPE FOR ROANOKE IN THE FIRST PERIOD. BUT THE STORM TOOK A 2-1 LEAD EARLY IN THE SECOND PERIOD ON A WEILAND PARRISH GOAL ALL THE WAY INTO THE CLOSING MINUTES OF THE THIRD PERIOD. STE-PHEN ALVO TIED THE GAME ON A POWER PLAY STRIKE AT 14:25, THEN ALEX DICARLO'S COMPOSED REBOUND FINISH GAVE ROANOKE THE 3-2 WIN.

ROUDEBUSH IS THE MAN

GOALTENDER AUSTYN ROUDEBUSH HAS BEEN A FORCE IN NET FOR THE DAWGS OVER THE LAST TWO YEARS. WINNING 49 WINS IN THE LAST TWO REGULAR SEASONS. IN HIS PLAYOFF CAREER FOR THE DAWGS. THE TOLEDO NATIVE IS 10-3-1. REGISTERING A .924 SAVE PERCENTAGE. A 2.23 GOALS AGAINST AVERAGE. AND TWO SHUTOUTS. HE MADE 32 SAVES ON TUESDAY, AND STOPPED 28-OF-30 SHOTS LAST NIGHT.

STORM NEWS AND NOTES

USTASKI, MATTSON LEAD STORM

QUAD CITY HAS DEEN AN OFFENSIVE JUGGERNAUT THIS YEAR, WITH THREE OF THE LEAGUE'S LEADING GOALSCORERS IN COLE GOLKA, LEIF MATTSON, AND MATT USTASKI. GOLKA IS CURRENTLY ON THE Injured reserve, meaning ustaski, who has 27 goals and 26 assists, and mattson with 25 goals and 28 assists, will have to lead the storm against roanoke. Quad city has been an excellent goalscoring team (third in the league at 3.45 gpg), but despite a strong year from goalie brent moran, the defense has struggled in giving up a lot of goals and chances at large this season. They'll be challenged by roanoke's league-leading scoring offense in this series. Mattson scored once and had an assist on tuesday.

STATUS IN THE AIR FOR MAJOR CONTRIBUTORS?

FOUR PLAYERS FOR THE STORM JUST CAME OFF OF THE INJURED RESERVE WITHIN THE PAST WEEK OR TWO – MATT USTASKI, DILLON FOURNIER, JOHN SCHIAVO, AND DARREN MCCORMICK. SCHIAVO HAS SIX GOALS AND 10 ASSISTS THIS YEAR, AND BOASTS CAREER SPHL STATS OF 61 GOALS, 94 ASSISTS, AND A PRESIDENT'S CUP CHAMPIONSHIP RING WITH HUNTSVILLE IN 2018-2019. MCCORMICK HAS FOUR GOALS AND 17 ASSISTS THIS YEAR, AND HAS NOTCHED 159 POINTS IN 194 CAREER SPHL GAMES DATING BACK TO 2017, INCLUDING THREE 20-PLUS GOAL SEASONS AND A PRESIDENT'S CUP TITLE WITH PENSACOLA IN THE 2020-2021 CAMPAIGN. USTASKI HAS BEEN A GAME-BREAKING SHARPSHOOTER THIS YEAR, WITH 27 GOALS IN JUST 35 GAMES EN ROUTE TO WHAT WILL BE AN ALL-SPHL CALIBER SEASON. FOURNIER HAS BEEN AMONG THE LEAGUE'S TOP SIX OR SEVEN DEFENSEMEN THIS YEAR, WITH FOUR GOALS AND 30 ASSISTS FROM THE BLUE LINE THIS YEAR. WITH GOLKA'S 32 GOALS AND 21 ASSISTS OUT OF THE LINEUP DUE TO INJURY, LOOK FOR THAT GROUP, PLUS PLAYERS LIKE PAT MARCINKEVICS AND LOGAN NELSON, TO TRY AND FILL THE VOID OF GOLKA.

MORAN LOVES PLAYING THE DAWGS IN NET

GOALTENDER BRENT MORAN HAS BEEN THE LEADER IN NET FOR THE STORM THIS YEAR, GOING 21-11-1 WITH A .922 SAVE PERCENTAGE AND A 2.81 GOALS AGAINST AVERAGE FOR QUAD CITY THIS SEASON. THE FORMER FAYETTEVILLE GOALTENDER HAS OWNED THE DAWGS SINCE FIRST PLAYING AGAINST ROANOKE BACK IN THE 2021-2022 SEASON, GOING 10-1-2 WITH A 2.17 GOALS AGAINST AVERAGE AND A .935 SAVE PERCENTAGE IN 14 CAREER APPEARANCES AGAINST ROANOKE COUNTING TUESDAY'S WIN OVER THE DAWGS. IN HIS SPHL CAREER, MORAN IS 41-18-4 WITH A .922 SAVE CLIP AND A 2.72 GOALS AGAINST AVERAGE.

PLAYOFF SERIES HISTORY 2018 PRESIDENT'S CUP

DAWGS SWEPT BY TOP-SEEDED RIVERMEN

THE FIRST-EVER PLAYOFF GAME IN FRANCHISE HISTORY TOOK PLACE AT THE LAHAYE CENTER IN LYNCHBURG, AS ROANOKE FELL 3-2 TO PEORIA. ON LESS THAN A 48-HOUR TURNARDUND. ROANOKE DROPPED GAME TWO TO THE RIVERMEN 4-1.

2019 PRESIDENT'S CUP

DAWGS ACCEPT PEORIA CHALLENGE, THEN EDGED IN SEMIS BY BULLS

IN THE CHALLENGE ROUND, TOP-SEEDED PEORIA DECIDED TO PLAY FIFTH-PLACE ROANOKE INSTEAD OF THE THREE LOWER-RANKED TEAMS THAT THE RIVERMEN COULD HAVE CHOSEN FROM. THE DAWGS RESPONDED TO THE LACK OF RESPECT PAID TO THEM, AND TOOK DOWN PEORIA 4-3 AT BERGLUND CENTER IN GAME ONE. GAME TWO SAW ROANOKE LEAP OUT TO A 4-0 LEAD, AND THE DAWGS HELD ON DESPITE EIGHT POWER PLAY CHANCES BY THE RIVERMEN TO SECURE THE SERIES SWEEP WITH A 4-3 VICTORY. THAT TOOK ROANOKE TO THE SEMIFINALS TO FACE OFF WITH BINMINGHAM. THE DAWGS DROPPED A TIGHT GAME ONE BY A SCORE OF 4-3. ROANOKE HANDLED BUSINESS ON THE ROAD IN GAME TWO, KEEPING BIRMINGHAM OFF THE BOARD FOR THE FIRST 57 MINUTES OF THE GAME IN A 4-1 WIN. GAME THREE WAS A BACK-AND-FORTH AFFAIR, WITH BIRMINGHAM SCORING THE FIRST TWO GOALS, ROANOKE ANSWERING WITH FOUR CONSECUTIVE SCORES, AND THEN THE BULLS CLOSED IT OUT WITH FOUR UNANSWERED GOALS OF THEIR OWN TO WIN 6-4.

2022 PRESIDENT'S CUP

DIRTY DAWGS MAKE CINDERELLA RUN, LOSE IN FIRST FINALS APPEARANCE Roanoke entered the postseason in 2022 as the Eighth and Final seed to make the sphl field. Taking on a knoxville team that set a new League record for wins on the year, roanoke bounced back from a 4-1 game one loss at knoxville to the the series in a 5-1 game two Blowout at berglund center. On easter sunday, the dawgs scored twice in the first five minutes, and held on for a 3-1 win that upset the top-seeded ice bears. Roanoke matched up with two-seed huntsville in the semifinals, and stormed past the havoc 5-3 in game one. A 36-save shutout by Austyn Roudebush in game two led Roanoke to a 2-0 win, and a series sweep. In the finals against the peoria rivermen, the dawgs fell in the closing moments of game one 3-2 before getting thumped 7-3 in game two. Roanoke extended the series with A 4-3 game three win at home, but peoria won the title 3-2 in overtime in game form.

2023 PRESIDENT'S CUP

DAWGS TAKE CARE OF UNFINISHED BUSINESS, WIN FIRST PRESIDENT'S CUP After A record-breaking 32 wins and a fourth-place reuglar season finish, the dawgs would face evansville in the first round of the Postseason. A 4-2 win on the road in game one was followed by A 4-0 game two shutout win, with Austyn Roudebush Stopping ALI 32 shots he faced. The semifinals were set for a rematch of the 2022 final against the top-seeded peopla Rivermen, and Roanoke would win game one 3-2 at home. After falling 5-3 at peopla in game two, the dawgs roared out to A 3-0 first period lead to chase reigning president's cup myp Jack Berry from the Rivermen NET. The Dawgs would belo no for A 5-3 win to get back to the final, with nick topitot falling five gals in games two and three combined. In the final against birmingham, the dawgs would split the first two road games in Alabama with A 4-2 win and A 2-0 shutout loss. Game three in Roanoke was one of the most entertaining games in Franchise History, as the back-and-forth game would need overtime. A shot by dom marginkevics was tipped in by billy vizo, and Roanoke secured a 5-4 win in to to take the series lead. 
