DAWGS NEWS AND NOTES

ROANOKE HOPES TO RUN IT BACK

ROANOKE ENTERED ITS FIRST ROUND SERIES WITH QUAD CITY AS THE THREE SEED, STARTING ON THE ROAD IN GAME ONE WITH A 3-2 OT LOSS BEFORE WINNING 3-2 AND 7-1 AT HOME ON FRIDAY AND SATURDAY. IN THE LAST TWO PLAYOFF RUNS. ROANOKE HAD GONE 12-6 EN ROUTE TO TWO APPERANCES IN THE FINAL AND ONE PRESIDENT'S CUP TITLE.

DAWGS STUMBLE ON THE ROAD

THE DAWGS WILL HAVE THEIR BACKS AGAINST THE WALL AGAIN TONIGHT AFTER FALLING 5-2 IN GAME ONE ON THE ROAD AT HUNTSVILLE. ROANOKE PLAYED FAIRLY WELL IN THE FIRST 30 MINUTES OF THE GAME. OUT-SHOOTING THE HAVOC 23-16 UP TO THAT POINT. BUT THE FINAL SEVEN SHOTS OF THE SECOND PERIOD WERE ALL BY HUNTSVILLE. AS THE HAVOC SCORED TWICE LATE IN THE SECOND AND TWO MORE EARLY GOALS IN THE THIRD PERIOD TO PULL AWAY FROM THE DAWGS.

ROUDEBUSH IS THE MAN

GOALTENDER AUSTYN ROUDEBUSH HAS BEEN A FORCE IN NET FOR THE DAWGS OVER THE LAST TWO YEARS, WINNING 49 WINS IN THE LAST TWO REGULAR SEASONS. IN HIS PLAYOFF CAREER FOR THE DAWGS. THE TOLEDO NATIVE IS 11-4-1. REGISTERING A .922 SAVE PERCENTAGE, A 2.36 GOALS AGAINST AVERAGE, AND TWO SHUTOUTS. HE STOPPED 58-OF-61 SHOTS FACING ELIMINATION IN GAMES TWO AND THREE LAST WEEKEND. BUT WAS CHASED IN GAME ONE AFTER ALLOWING FIVE GOALS ON 31 SHOTS (HE STOPPED THE FIRST 16).

HAVOC NEWS AND NOTES

COACH STU TAKES THE REINS

NEW HEAD COACH STUART STEFAN IS NO STRANGER TO HUNTSVILLE – THE FORMER DEFENSEMAN PLAYED SEVEN SEASONS FOR THE HAVOC FROM 2011-2018 AND HAS BEEN A COACH IN SOME CAPACITY (PLAYER-ASST OR JUST ASST.) SINCE 2016. HE WAS NAMED TO FIVE ALL-SPHL TEAMS, WON DEFENSEMAN OF THE YEAR ONCE, AND WAS A MEMBER OF HUNTSVILLE'S 2018 PRESIDENT'S CUP CHAMPION-SHIP TEAM AS A PLAYER-COACH AND AGAIN IN 2019 AS JUST A COACH. STEFAN TAKES OVER FOR GLENN DETULLEO, WHO LED THE HAVOC FOR NEARLY 12 SEASONS.

BALANCED ATTACK LEADS THE WAY

FOR A HUNTSVILLE TEAM THAT LOST FOUR OF THE SPHL'S TOP EIGHT ACTIVE LEADERS IN POINTS AT THE END OF THE 2022-2023 SEASON, FORMER CAPTAIN TYLER PIACENTINI (ASSISTANT COACH), SY NUTKEVICH, ROB DARRAR, AND JACOB BARBER, A NEW WAVE OF BALANCE UP FRONT HAS LED THE WAY FOR THE HAVOC. EIGHT DIFFERENT PLAYERS TALLIED AT LEAST 30 POINTS THIS YEAR, INCLUDING VETERAN DEFENSEMAN ALEX KIELCZEWSKI AT 32 POINTS, AND A PLEHTORA OF ROOKIES LIKE DYLAN STEWART (45 POINTS), BUSTER LARSSON (43 POINTS), PHIL ELGSTAM (41 POINTS), AND ERIC HENDERSON (40 POINTS). WITH OTHER VETERANS LIKE KYLE CLARKE (35 POINTS), ROBBIE FISHER (17 GOALS), AND DAVID THOMSON (32 POINTS), HUNTSVILLE IS SIMILAR TO ROANOKE IN THAT THE HAVOC HAVE LOT OF DIFFERENT PLAYERS THAT CAN SUPPLY POINTS IN THE CLUTCH MOMENTS. LARSSON DOMINATED GAME ONE ON WEDNESDAY, TALLYING FOUR GOALS IN THE 5-2 WIN BY THE HAVOC.

ELGSTAM BROTHERS OUT IN FULL FORCE

DOUG AND PHIL ELGSTAM HAVE BEEN EXCELLENT FOR THE HAVOC SINCE ARRIVING TO HUNTSVILLE THIS FALL. DOUG HAD 13 GOALS AND 14 ASSISTS IN 37 GAMES, WHILE PHIL HAS 17 GOALS AND 24 Assists in 50 games. Doug previously played at suny-cortland and also played 36 games for pensacola in the 2021-2022 season, notching 11 goals and 20 assists in 36 games for the ice flyers, as well as four assists in the three playoff games pensacola played against eventual champions peoria. In five games against roanoke, the elgstam brothers have combined for four goals and seven assists.

PLAYOFF SERIES HISTORY 2018 PRESIDENT'S CUP

DAWGS SWEPT BY TOP-SEEDED RIVERMEN

THE FIRST-EVER PLAYOFF GAME IN FRANCHISE HISTORY TOOK PLACE AT THE LAHAYE CENTER IN LYNCHBURG, AS ROANOKE FELL 3-2 TO PEORIA. ON LESS THAN A 48-HOUR TURNAROUND. ROANOKE DROPPED GAME TWO TO THE RIVERMEN 4-1.

2019 PRESIDENT'S CUP

DAWGS ACCEPT PEORIA CHALLENGE, THEN EDGED IN SEMIS BY BULLS

IN THE CHALLENGE ROUND, TOP-SEEDED PEORIA DECIDED TO PLAY FIFTH-PLACE ROANOKE INSTEAD OF THE THREE LOWER-RANKED TEAMS THAT THE RIVERMEN COULD HAVE CHOSEN FROM. THE DAWGS RESPONDED TO THE LACK OF RESPECT PAID TO THEM, AND TOOK DOWN PEORIA 4-3 AT BERGLUND CENTER IN GAME ONE. GAME TWO SAW ROANOKE LEAP OUT TO A 4-0 LEAD, AND THE DAWGS HELD ON DESPITE EIGHT POWER PLAY CHANCES BY THE RIVERMEN TO SECURE THE SERIES SWEEP WITH A 4-3 VICTORY. 
