## GAME PREVIEW

### ADIRONDACK ARRIVALS

Two different Dawgs had been playing for the ECHL's Adirondack Thunder, but this week both Nick Devito and Nick Ford returned to Roanoke. Devito has yet to appear for Roanoke after being placed on the team's protected list the past two seasons, and will make his debut for the Dawgs tonight. Ford tallied two goals and three assists in six games before he was called up to Adirondack, and will play his first game for Roanoke since November 13 tonight.

### JANSEN AND JONES LEAD THE WAY

Mac Jansen and Jeff Jones are two of the most prolific scorers in team history, and they've both heated up recently. Jansen leads the team with nine goals and 15 points, all of which have come in his last nine games. He netted a hat trick and an assist in the 5-2 win over Fayetteville on November 24, and added another goal and an assist last Friday night. Jones has five goals and seven assists this year, including one goal and three assists in the two games against the Marksmen last week.

### DOWN TWO CAPTAINS

Mac Jansen will wear the 'A' tonight, as both Josh Nenadal and Brant Sherwood, Roanoke's away alternate captains, are out due to injury and suspension respectively.

## SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

### MISSING MARKSMEN

Fayetteville's roster has been ravaged over the past month by injuries and call ups to the ECHL. Among those missing in action due to injury are Tanner Froeze, Shane Bednard, and Drake Glover, while Carlos Fornaris and Marly Quince were recently called up to the ECHL.

Tonight, Wyatt Noskey, Zac Boyle, Taylor Best, and Stefano Durante are all also listed as inactive for undisclosed reasons. That's about half of the roster that started the month of November, and many of them are among the team's top contributors, that are unavailable currently for Fayetteville. Seven players who did not face Roanoke last week will be on the roster tonight, including defenseman Carter Struthers, who returned from his call up to the ECHL.

### PAWLOSKI PREVENTS A SWEEP

Fayetteville goaltender Jason Pawloski has been arguably the best goaltender in the SPHL so far this season, and he showed that last Friday night in Fayetteville's 3-2 win over Roanoke. Facing a barrage of Roanoke shots during a slow offensive night for his own teammates, Pawloski made a plethora of fantastic saves to keep his team in the game. With less than five minutes remaining, the Marksmen broke through with back-to-back goals within 26 seconds of each other. But it was all due to Pawloski, who saved 38 of Roanoke's 40 shots and earned a win despite the Marksmen only recording 19 shots on goal.

### MCNAIR AND MCCLOY MUST PRODUCE

Fayetteville rookie forward Matt McNair is tied for fourth in the SPHL in points with 17 to date, thanks to his six goals and 11 assists. He also leads all rookies in points and assists, and is tied for second for goals. Taylor McCloy leads the team with eight goals this season, and has 13 points on the year. With all of the injuries stacking up against the team, this duo must lead the Marksmen this weekend if they hope to earn results.
