## GAME PREVIEW

### DAWGS ARE STREAKING

The team had a three-game winning streak snapped in Knoxville on Sunday, but is still on a four-game point streak entering tonight's matchup. Jeff Jones is on a six-game point streak, the longest of any Dawg so far this season (4 G, 5 A). Brady Heppner (4 G, 1 A) and CJ Stubbs (2 G, 3 A) are each on four-game point streaks, and Mac Jansen is on a three-game point streak (1 G, 3 A).

### TAXI SQUAD SHAKEUPS

With the new NHL taxi squad rules creating a domino effect throughout the pro hockey landscape, the Dawgs saw four players called up to the ECHL this week, and brought in two new players of their own. Among those called up were Nick Ford (Jacksonville), Nick Devito (Idaho), Brody Claeys (Worcester), and Dillon Hill (Fort Wayne). Forward Jesse Anderson and defenseman Egor Kostiuikov have arrived in the past few days of transactions for Roanoke.

### HUGE HOMESTAND

This is the first of four straight home games for Roanoke, with first-place Huntsville in town tomorrow night and red-hot Peoria visiting Roanoke next weekend. The Dawgs are in the midst of playing nine out of 11 games at Berglund Center, winning all three home games so far.

## SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

### PAWLOSKI PRIED AWAY

One casualty from the NHL announcement was Fayetteville's star goaltender Jason Pawloski, who was called up to the ECHL's Worcester Railers this week. Pawloski was ranked second in the SPHL in wins (12) and fourth in goals against average (2.01 GAA) when he left for Worcester, leaving backup goalie Stefano Durante in his place. Durante has played in five games this year, with a .875 save percentage, a 3.42 goals against average, and a 2-2-0 record.

### WILL BEDNARD SUIT UP?

Shane Bednard played in two games leading into the matchup with the Dawgs on December 23 after a long stint on the injured reserve list, but sat out of the 4-3 overtime win by Roanoke last Thursday after he took a hard hit against Macon the weekend prior. He is currently listed on the active roster, and could very well be back in the lineup tonight for the Marksmen. In nine games this season, the forward has tallied one goal, five assists, and a plus-two (+/-) rating.

### ROANOKE ROARS BACK

Fayetteville was starting to become very comfortable at Berglund Center, winning its first three trips to play Roanoke this season and gliding with a 3-1 lead with 6:30 remaining in the third period on December 23. Goals by Roanoke's Jeff Jones and Brady Heppner at 14:29 and 18:31 tied the game, and CJ Stubbs scored the winner for the Dawgs in overtime. The series record this year stands at 3-3-1 for both teams, and the home team in this matchup has only won twice in seven meetings – with both victories coming in the past two games and both results taking place in overtime. This will be the eighth meeting between these two squads this season, and marks the start of a stretch where they play each other seven of the next 15 games.
