## GAME PREVIEW

### UNDERDAWGS ENTER PLAYOFFS FOR THIRD TIME

Roanoke enters the President's Cup playoffs for the third time in franchise history, and will take on a Knoxville side that it just split with two weekends ago. In seven matchups against Knoxville this season, the Dawgs went 2-3-2, with 1-1-2 record in the four games that were decided by one goal or less. Roanoke will host Knoxville for Game Two on Saturday night at Berglund Center.

### MAC-NIFICENT SEASON

For the first time in franchise history, a Dawgs skater hit the 60-point mark. Mac Jansen set a new single-season record for points after already breaking the goals mark earlier this year, finishing with 29 scores and 31 assists. After enduring a 10-game goalless streak, Jansen has four goals and two assists in his last four outings, including three goals and an assist in the series against Knoxville to start April. Jansen leads all players in the season series with five goals in seven games against the Ice Bears.

### FORMER TEAM AWAITS AUSTYN, SAMMY, AND SARGIS

After a top campaign last season for Knoxville, Austyn Roudebush returned to Roanoke and recorded the third most minutes played by any goalie in the SPHL this season. Sammy Bernard has gone 4-2-1 in net for the Dawgs since he was claimed off of waivers from the Ice Bears, and Gehrett Sargis has five goals and four assists in 13 games for the Dawgs after a long career in Knoxville.

## SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

### SHOTS FIRED BEFORE HEATED MATCHUP

After a spirited split in a two-game series at Berglund two weeks ago between these teams, Knoxville head coach Jeff Carr had a very opinionated take on Roanoke's style of play. "They're a dirty, undisciplined hockey team," said Carr to local media on Monday of this week. That prompted Roanoke head coach Dan Bremner to respond by saying "He can worry about whatever he wants, we're going to worry about hockey." Judging by the last two times these teams met, there was already plenty of bad blood between the two teams, and now with a President's Cup and plenty of verbal jabs taking place, the ante has been raised for tonight's matchup.

### TOP TENDING TANDEM?

Knoxville's top two goaltenders are both finally back to the team in time for the playoffs, and the duo might just be the most formidable behind the pipes throughout the SPHL. Jimmy Poreda saw time in both the ECHL and AHL this season, and is 14-2-1 with the Ice Bears with a .927 save clip and a 2.15 goals against average. His backup Kristian Stead has played in seven more games for Knoxville, but has also been strong with a 18-2-1 record, .923 save percentage, and a 2.20 goals against average. Stead's only two regulation losses came at Berglund Center during Roanoke's 5-1 Military Night win back on February 5 and on April 1 in Roanoke's 3-2 victory. Stead was also named to the league's All-Rookie Team on Wednesday.

### BELLANT BACKED BY VETS

Rookie Andrew Bellant has been great with the Ice Bears when he's been back from ECHL call-ups this season, with 21 goals and 19 assists in just 36 SPHL games this season. Combine that with six forwards that have 40 or more points this season and you'll see how the Ice Bears have had success offensively as the top-scoring team in the league this year. Dean Balsamo leads the team with 27 goals, Anthony McVeigh is the top point man with 59 points (21 goals, 38 assists), and Stepan Timofeyev brings a blend of speed and skill that must be respected, as Roanoke fans saw when Timofeyev's 'Michigan' goal turned the tide of the 6-1 victory by Knoxville back on February 26 over the Dawgs.

### NO RAZ-ZLE DAZZLE?

The lone blow for Knoxville's lineup was the injury to center Razmuz Waxin-Engback that may well end his season. In 51 games this year, Waxin-Engback had 22 goals and 32 assists for the Ice Bears, in addition to a team-best nine power play goals. He will not be available against Roanoke.

## PLAYOFF SERIES HISTORY

### 2018 President's Cup

#### DAWGS SWEEP BY TOP-SEEDED RIVERMEN

The first-ever playoff game in franchise history took place at the LaHaye Center in Lynchburg, as Roanoke fell 3-2 to Peoria. Colin Murray scored Roanoke's first playoff goal on the power play in the first period, and Steve Mele tied the score at 2-2 late in the second period. On less than a 48-hour turnaround, Roanoke dropped Game Two to the Rivermen 4-1. A Joe Sova goal early in the third period brought the score within one goal before two late Peoria scores clinched them the two-game sweep over the Dawgs.

### 2019 President's Cup

#### DAWGS ACCEPT PEORIA CHALLENGE, THEN EDGED IN SEMIS BY BULLS

In the Challenge Round, top-seeded Peoria decided to play fifth-place Roanoke instead of the three lower-ranked teams that the Rivermen could have chosen from. The Dawgs responded to the lack of respect paid to them, and took down Peoria 4-3 at Berglund Center in Game One. Mac Jansen scored the first two goals for Roanoke, Colton Wolter tied the game in the third period, and Josh Nenadal netted the game-winning goal for the Dawgs with just 2:38 remaining in the game. Game Two saw Roanoke leap out to a 4-0 lead, and the Dawgs held on despite eight power play chances by the Rivermen to secure the series sweep with a 4-3 victory. Jordan Carvalho and Maxime Guyon each scored in the first period, and Guyon added the fourth goal after Cody Dion's tally in the second period. Jacob Caffrey made 41 saves in the series-deciding game. That took Roanoke to the semifinals to face off with Birmingham. The Dawgs dropped a tight Game One by a score of 4-3, despite a three-point performance by Mac Jansen and goals by Adrian Carbonara and Colin Murray. Roanoke handled business on the road in Game Two, keeping Birmingham off the board for the first 57 minutes of the game in a 4-1 win. Ben Bauer, Josh Nenadal, and Cam Bakker all scored, then Bakker added an empty net goal in the closing moments as added insurance. Game Three was a back-and-forth affair, with Birmingham scoring the first two goals, Roanoke answering with four consecutive scores, and then the Bulls closed it out with four unanswered goals of their own to win 6-4. Cody Dion and Mac Jansen each scored twice for the Dawgs, who were eliminated at Pelham Civic Complex.
