DAWGS NEWS AND NOTES

DAWGS DOMINATE ICE BEARS FOR FIRST WIN

ROANOKE GOT THE PARTY STARTED EARLY AND NEVER LOOKED BACK, TAKING DOWN KNOXVILLE IN ITS OWN HOME OPENER 5-0 ON FRIDAY NIGHT. THE DAWGS WERE LED IN NET BY A 42-SAVE SHUTOUT BY BRODY CLAEYS, THE THIRD SHUTOUT OF HIS SPHL CAREER, BUT HIS FIRST DURING HIS TIME WITH ROANOKE. GUSTAV MULLER ALSO HAD TWO GOALS AND AN ASSIST, JOE WIDMAR HAD THREE ASSISTS, KHRISTIAN ACOSTA HAD ONE GOAL AND ONE ASSIST, AND BOTH TREY AND MARCUS FECHKO BOTH NETTED THEIR FIRST PRO GOALS.

ROANOKE FINDING ITS GROOVE OFFENSIVELY

THE DAWGS ALREADY HAVE 11 DIFFERENT PLAYERS THAT HAVE RECORDED AT LEAST ONE POINT THROUGH THE FIRST TWO GAMES, AND HAVE ALSO NETTED THREE POWER PLAY GOALS ALREADY THIS SEASON. THE TOP TWO LINES WERE BUZZING LAST NIGHT - WIDMAR FLANKED BY THE FECHKO BROTHERS COMBINED FOR SIX POINTS, AND THE MULLER-BROUGHMAN-ACOSTA LINE ADDED ANOTHER SIX POINTS. THE DAWGS WILL LOOK TO KEEP UP THEIR OFFENSIVE FIREPOWER AGAINST A KNOXVILLE TEAM THAT HAS NOTCHED JUST ONE GOAL IN ITS FIRST TWO GAMES.

DAWGS BOAST EXPERIENCE & STABILITY IN NET

BRODY CLAEYS RECORDED HIS THIRD CAREER SPHL SHUTOUT LAST NIGHT, STOPPING ALL 42 SHOTS FROM KNOXVILLE IN THE ROAD WIN. CLAEYS HAS 81 CAREER SPHL GAMES UNDER HIS BELT, INCLUDING 29 WITH ROANOKE. PAIR THAT WITH AUSTYN ROUDEBUSH'S 109 CAREER SPHL WINS, WHICH RANKS JUST TWO VICTORIES AWAY FROM THE ALL-TIME SPHL RECORD IN THAT CATEGORY, AND ROANOKE FANS CAN FEEL CONFIDENT WITH EITHER OF THOSE TWO VETERANS BETWEEN THE PIPES.

ICE BEARS NEWS AND NOTES

GURSKIS ENTERS SECOND SEASON AFTER SURPRISE POSTSEASON RUN

KNOXVILLE CLEANED HOUSE AFTER MISSING THE PLAYOFFS FOR THE FIRST TIME IN FRANCHISE HISTORY FOLLOWING A LAST-PLACE FINISH IN THE 2023-2024 SEASON. NEW HEAD COACH JOHN GURSKIS HAD SPENT THE PREVIOUS FIVE SEASONS AS THE ASSISTANT COACH FOR THE ECHL'S WICHITA THUNDER, BUT LED THE ICE BEARS TO A 25-24-7 RECORD LAST YEAR TO PUSH KNOXVILLE BACK INTO THE PRESIDENT'S CUP PLAYOFFS. FOLLOWING A GAME ONE LOSS TO ROANOKE, KNOXVILLE ROARED TO LIFE TO WIN FOUR OF ITS NEXT FIVE GAMES AGAINST ROANOKE AND BIRMINGHAM TO ADVANCE TO THE PRESIDENT'S CUP FINALS BEFORE LOSING TO EVANSVILLE. KNOXVILLE IS JUST 6-17-2 AGAINST ROANOKE SINCE THE START OF THE 2023-24 SEASON HEAD-TO-HEAD.

SOPER, WILLIAMS, BRANCHEAU LEAD THE WAY FOR ICE BEARS

JIMMY SOPER ARRIVED IN KNOXVILLE LAST SEASON AS THE TEAM'S NEW CAPTAIN AFTER LEAVING AN EXTENSIVE STINT IN THE ECHL. SERVING AS AN ALTERNATE CAPTAIN FOR MOST OF THE 2023-24 SEASON WITH RAPID CITY IN THE ECHL. SOPER HAS 47 GOALS, 75 ASSISTS, AND 240 PIMS IN 228 CAREER ECHL GAMES, WHILE ALSO NOTCHING 37 GOALS, 51 ASSISTS, AND 229 PIM IN 166 CAREER SPHL GAMES BETWEEN KNOXVILLE AND MACON. TYLER WILLIAMS (37 POINTS IN 52 GAMES) AND JASON BRANCHEAU (34 POINTS IN 50 GAMES) WERE KEY PIECES AS WELL IN THEIR ROOKIE SEASONS, AND ARE BACK FOR THEIR SECOND PRO SEASONS EXPECTING TO TAKE A STEP UP FOR THE ICE BEARS. ADD IN RETURNERS SUCH AS RYAN KUZMICH AND ERIC OLSON UP FRONT AND CARSON VANCE, BRENDAN DOWLER, AND CAM TOBEY ON THE BLUE LINE, AND THE ICE BEARS' ROSTER SHAPES UP VERY WELL ENTERING THE NEW SEASON. NOT TO MENTION, ARRIVALS FROM ELSEWHERE AROUND THE SPHL INCLUDE FORWARD BLAKE TOSTO (SCORED AT FAYETTEVILLE ON SATURDAY) AND DEFENSEMEN TROY BUTTON AND JARRET KUP.

MUNDINGER BACK BETWEEN THE PIPES

STEPHEN MUNDINGER WAS THE MAIN MAN IN NET FOR THE ICE BEARS WITH A 18-13-5 RECORD PLUS A .909 SAVE CLIP AND A 2.97 GOALS AGAINST AVERAGE IN 40 GAMES DURING THE 2024-25 REGULAR SEASON. HE WENT TO A DIFFERENT LEVEL IN THE POSTSEASON, GOING 4-2-2 WITH A .948 SAVE PERCENTAGE AND A 2.14 GOALS AGAINST AVERAGE DURING KNOXVILLE'S RUN TO THE FINALS. HIS 44-SAVE SHUTOUT OF ROANOKE IN GAME TWO OF THE FIRST ROUND MARKED THE FOURTH-MOST SAVES BY A GOALIE DURING A SHUTOUT IN A PRESIDENT'S CUP PLAYOFF GAME THROUGHOUT THE 21-YEAR HISTORY OF THE SPHL. AFTER STOPPING 28-OF-30 SHOTS IN KNOXVILLE'S 2-1 LOSS TO FAYETTEVILLE ON OPENING WEEKEND, IT SEEMS THAT MUNDINGER IS POISED FOR ANOTHER STRONG YEAR FOR THE ICE BEARS.

PLAYOFF SERIES HISTORY

2018 PRESIDENT'S CUP

DAWGS SWEEP BY TOP-SEEDED RIVERMEN

THE FIRST-EVER PLAYOFF GAME IN FRANCHISE HISTORY TOOK PLACE AT THE LAHAYE CENTER IN LYNCHBURG, AS ROANOKE FELL 3-2 TO PEORIA. ON LESS THAN A 48-HOUR TURNAROUND, ROANOKE DROPPED GAME TWO TO THE RIVERMEN 4-1.

2019 PRESIDENT'S CUP

DAWGS ACCEPT PEORIA CHALLENGE, THEN EDGED IN SEMIS BY BULLS

IN THE CHALLENGE ROUND, TOP-SEEDED PEORIA CHOSE FIFTH-PLACE ROANOKE INSTEAD OF THE THREE LOWER-RANKED TEAMS THAT THE RIVERMEN COULD HAVE PLAYED. THE DAWGS TOOK DOWN PEORIA 4-3 AT HOME IN GAME ONE. GAME TWO SAW ROANOKE LEAP OUT TO A 4-0 LEAD, AND THE DAWGS HELD ON DESPITE EIGHT POWER PLAY CHANCES BY THE RIVERMEN TO SWEEP THE SERIES WITH A 4-3 VICTORY. THAT TOOK ROANOKE TO THE SEMIFINALS TO FACE BIRMINGHAM, WHERE THE DAWGS SPLIT THE FIRST TWO GAMES BEFORE FALLING 6-4 IN THE DECISIVE GAME THREE.

2022 PRESIDENT'S CUP

DIRTY DAWGS MAKE CINDERELLA RUN, LOSE IN FIRST FINALS APPEARANCE

ROANOKE ENTERED THE PLAYOFFS AS THE EIGHTH SEED., TAKING ON A KNOXVILLE TEAM THAT SET A NEW LEAGUE RECORD FOR WINS ON THE YEAR. ROANOKE BOUNCED BACK FROM A 4-1 GAME ONE ROAD LOSS TO TIE THE SERIES IN A 5-1 GAME TWO BLOWOUT AT HOME. ON EASTER SUNDAY, THE DAWGS SCORED TWICE IN THE FIRST FIVE MINUTES, AND HELD ON FOR A 3-1 WIN THAT UPSET THE TOP-SEEDED ICE BEARS. ROANOKE FACED SECOND-SEEDED HUNTSVILLE IN THE SEMIFINALS, AND STORMED PAST THE HAVOC 5-3 IN GAME ONE. A 36-SAVE SHUTOUT BY AUSTYN ROUDEBUSH IN GAME TWO LED ROANOKE TO A 2-0 WIN TO SWEEP THE SERIES. IN THE FINAL AGAINST THE PEORIA RIVERMEN, THE DAWGS LOST GAMES ONE AND TWO ON THE ROAD BEFORE EXTENDING THE SERIES WITH A 4-3 GAME THREE WIN AT HOME, BUT PEORIA WON THE TITLE 3-2 IN OVERTIME IN GAME FOUR.

2023 PRESIDENT'S CUP

DAWGS TAKE CARE OF UNFINISHED BUSINESS, WIN FIRST PRESIDENT'S CUP

AFTER A FOURTH-PLACE REGULAR SEASON FINISH, THE DAWGS FACED EVANSVILLE IN THE FIRST ROUND. A 4-2 WIN ON THE ROAD IN GAME ONE WAS FOLLOWED BY A 4-0 GAME TWO SHUTOUT WIN BY ROUDEBUSH AS ROANOKE SWEEP THE SERIES. THE SEMIFINALS SET A REMATCH OF THE 2022 FINAL AGAINST THE TOP-SEEDED PEORIA RIVERMEN, AND ROANOKE WON GAME ONE 3-2 AT HOME. AFTER FALLING 5-3 AT PEORIA IN GAME TWO, THE DAWGS ROARED OUT TO A 3-0 FIRST PERIOD LEAD AND HELD ON FOR A 5-3 WIN TO GET BACK TO THE FINAL, WITH NICK DEVITO TALLYING FIVE GOALS IN GAMES TWO & THREE COMBINED. IN THE FINAL AGAINST BIRMINGHAM, THE DAWGS WOULD SPLIT THE FIRST TWO ROAD GAMES IN ALABAMA WITH A 4-2 WIN AND A 2-0 SHUTOUT LOSS. GAME THREE IN ROANOKE SAW A BACK-AND-FORTH GAME GO TO OVERTIME.
