DAWGS NEWS AND NOTES

DAWGS WIN THIRD STRAIGHT FRIDAY NIGHT

THE DAWGS TOOK DOWN HUNTSVILLE 2-1 ON FRIDAY NIGHT BEHIND 27 SAVES AND A .964 SAVE PERCENTAGE FROM AUSTYN ROUDEBUSH, WHO WAS PLAYING IN HIS 200TH CAREER GAME WITH THE DAWGS. GOALS FROM MATT DORSEY AND MATT O'DEA HELPED ROANOKE START THE WEEKEND IN THE WIN COLUMN. THE DAWGS HAVE NOW TIED THEIR LONGEST WINNING AT THREE GAMES FOR THE FIFTH TIME THIS SEASON, AND ONE MORE WIN TONIGHT WOULD SWEEP THE WEEKEND SET AND GIVE ROANOKE ITS LONGEST WIN STREAK SINCE LAST FEBRUARY.

OFFENSE HAS BEEN ROLLING

AFTER BEING SWEEPED AT HOME BY PEORIA ON FEBRUARY 6-7 AND SCORING JUST TWO GOALS ACROSS THAT WEEKEND, THE DAWGS HAVE FLIPPED THE SCRIPT OFFENSIVELY. SINCE FEBRUARY 8, ROANOKE HAS ERUPTED FOR 35 GOALS OVER ITS LAST EIGHT GAMES, AVERAGING 4.38 GOALS PER GAME, BOTH MARKS LEADING THE SPHL DURING THAT STRETCH. THIS OFFENSIVE SURGE HAS SPARKED A LATE-SEASON PUSH, HELPING THE DAWGS CLIMB THE STANDINGS. OVER THE LAST EIGHT GAMES, ROANOKE IS 6-2-0 AND ENTERS SATURDAY NIGHT TIED FOR THIRD PLACE IN THE SPHL STANDINGS.

WELCOME TO THE PARTY, ROOKIES

AS THE SEASON WINDS DOWN, THE DAWGS HAVE TURNED TO TOP COLLEGIATE STANDOUTS TO MAKE THEIR SPHL DEBUTS AND CONTRIBUTE DOWN THE STRETCH. LAST WEEKEND, FORMER SUNY-POTSDAM STANDOUT RYAN MAHLMEISTER MADE AN IMMEDIATE IMPACT, RECORDING THREE ASSISTS IN HIS FIRST WEEKEND. ROOKIE FORWARD CADEN PATTISON MADE HIS HOME DEBUT LAST NIGHT ALONGSIDE CONNOR BERTAMINI AND MATT CARLSON, WHO BOTH MADE THEIR PROFESSIONAL DEBUTS. TONIGHT, LEBANON VALLEY COLLEGE PRODUCT CADE HELMER, SIGNED EARLIER THIS MORNING, LACES UP THE SKATES FOR HIS PROFESSIONAL DEBUT. IN TOTAL, SIX DAWGS HAVE MADE THEIR PROFESSIONAL DEBUTS IN THE LAST THREE WEEKS.

HAVOC NEWS AND NOTES

STEFAN LEADS HAVOC FOR THIRD SEASON

HEAD COACH STUART STEFAN FOLLOWED UP HIS STRONG FIRST SEASON, WHICH SAW THE HAVOC REACH THE 2024 PRESIDENT'S CUP FINAL, WITH A SECOND-PLACE REGULAR SEASON FINISH LAST YEAR. HOWEVER, HIS CONTENDING TEAM FELL SHORT IN THE FIRST ROUND OF THE 2025 PLAYOFFS TO THE EVENTUAL PRESIDENT'S CUP CHAMPION EVANSVILLE THUNDERBOLTS. STEFAN, A FORMER HAVOC DEFENSEMAN, PLAYED SEVEN SEASONS IN HUNTSVILLE FROM 2011-2018 AND HAS SERVED IN A COACHING ROLE (PLAYER-ASSISTANT OR ASSISTANT COACH) SINCE 2016. DURING HIS PLAYING CAREER, HE WAS NAMED TO FIVE ALL-SPHL TEAMS AND WON DEFENSEMAN OF THE YEAR ONCE. HE WAS ALSO A MEMBER OF HUNTSVILLE'S 2018 PRESIDENT'S CUP CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM AS A PLAYER-COACH AND AGAIN IN 2019 AS AN ASSISTANT COACH.

HAVOC MAKING MOVES

LIKE MANY SPHL TEAMS DOWN THE STRETCH, HUNTSVILLE HAS BROUGHT IN SOME NEW TALENT TO CLOSE OUT THE 2025-26 SEASON. ON THURSDAY, THE HAVOC SIGNED FORWARD DYLAN ROBBINS. THE ALPINE, NEW JERSEY NATIVE SPLIT HIS COLLEGIATE CAREER BETWEEN SACRED HEART UNIVERSITY (NCAA) AND THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS BOSTON (NCAA III). PRIOR TO ARRIVING IN HUNTSVILLE, ROBBINS APPEARED IN 116 GAMES OF COLLEGE HOCKEY. THE HAVOC ALSO SIGNED GOALTENDER ALEX PROCTOR ON TUESDAY TO ADD DEPTH BEHIND BRIAN WILSON, WHO STARTED ALL THREE GAMES LAST WEEKEND AS THE LONE GOALIE ON THE ROSTER. THE UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-SUPERIOR POSTED A 2.47 GAA AND A .910 SAVE PERCENTAGE DURING THE 2025-26 SEASON. BOTH ROBBINS AND PROCTOR ARE SLATED TO MAKE THEIR SPHL DEBUTS THIS WEEKEND. HUNTSVILLE ALSO BROUGHT BACK DEFENSEMAN CHARLIE RISK AND FORWARD CONNOR GALLOWAY LAST THURSDAY. FINALLY, THE HAVOC ACTIVATED FORWARD COLE REGINATO FROM IR THURSDAY. THE TEAM'S THIRD-LEADING POINT GETTER WILL PLAY IN HIS FIRST GAME SINCE FEBRUARY 16.

HUNTSVILLE HURTING WITH SCRATCHES

LAST NIGHT, THE HAVOC SCRATCHED FOUR PLAYERS FROM THE LINEUP IN THEIR LOSS TO THE DAWGS. FORWARDS JOSH KESTNER AND COLE REGINATO, ALONG WITH DEFENSEMEN BEN SCHULTHEIS AND CHARLIE RISK, DID NOT PLAY. IN TOTAL, HUNTSVILLE WAS WITHOUT TWO OF ITS TOP THREE GOAL SCORERS AND POINT PRODUCERS. BY THE NUMBERS, LAST NIGHT'S SCRATCHES ACCOUNTED FOR 22% OF HUNTSVILLE'S TOTAL GOALS THIS SEASON AND 23% OF THE TEAM'S TOTAL ASSISTS. JOSH KESTNER, WHO RANKS SECOND ON THE TEAM IN BOTH GOALS AND POINTS, DID NOT MAKE THE TRIP WITH THE TEAM THIS WEEKEND AND WILL BE SCRATCHED AGAIN TONIGHT.

PLAYOFF SERIES HISTORY

2018 PRESIDENT'S CUP

DAWGS SWEEP BY TOP-SEEDED RIVERMEN

THE FIRST-EVER PLAYOFF GAME IN FRANCHISE HISTORY TOOK PLACE AT THE LAHAYE CENTER IN LYNCHBURG, AS ROANOKE FELL 3-2 TO PEORIA. ON LESS THAN A 48-HOUR TURNAROUND, ROANOKE DROPPED GAME TWO TO THE RIVERMEN 4-1.

2019 PRESIDENT'S CUP

DAWGS ACCEPT PEORIA CHALLENGE, THEN EDGED IN SEMIS BY BULLS

IN THE CHALLENGE ROUND, TOP-SEEDED PEORIA CHOSE FIFTH-PLACE ROANOKE INSTEAD OF THE THREE LOWER-RANKED TEAMS THAT THE RIVERMEN COULD HAVE PLAYED. THE DAWGS TOOK DOWN PEORIA 4-3 AT HOME IN GAME ONE. GAME TWO SAW ROANOKE LEAP OUT TO A 4-0 LEAD, AND THE DAWGS HELD ON DESPITE EIGHT POWER PLAY CHANCES BY THE RIVERMEN TO SWEEP THE SERIES WITH A 4-3 VICTORY. THAT TOOK ROANOKE TO THE SEMIFINALS TO FACE BIRMINGHAM, WHERE THE DAWGS SPLIT THE FIRST TWO GAMES BEFORE FALLING 6-4 IN THE DECISIVE GAME THREE.

2022 PRESIDENT'S CUP

DIRTY DAWGS MAKE CINDERELLA RUN, LOSE IN FIRST FINALS APPEARANCE

ROANOKE ENTERED THE PLAYOFFS AS THE EIGHTH SEED., TAKING ON A KNOXVILLE TEAM THAT SET A NEW LEAGUE RECORD FOR WINS ON THE YEAR. ROANOKE BOUNCED BACK FROM A 4-1 GAME ONE ROAD LOSS TO TIE THE SERIES IN A 5-1 GAME TWO BLOWOUT AT HOME. ON EASTER SUNDAY, THE DAWGS SCORED TWICE IN THE FIRST FIVE MINUTES, AND HELD ON FOR A 3-1 WIN THAT UPSET THE TOP-SEEDED ICE BEARS. ROANOKE FACED SECOND-SEEDED HUNTSVILLE IN THE SEMIFINALS, AND STORMED PAST THE HAVOC 5-3 IN GAME ONE. A 36-SAVE SHUTOUT BY AUSTYN ROUDEBUSH IN GAME TWO LED ROANOKE TO A 2-0 WIN TO SWEEP THE SERIES. IN THE FINAL AGAINST THE PEORIA RIVERMEN, THE DAWGS LOST GAMES ONE AND TWO ON THE ROAD BEFORE EXTENDING THE SERIES WITH A 4-3 GAME THREE WIN AT HOME, BUT PEORIA WON THE TITLE 3-2 IN OVERTIME IN GAME FOUR.

2023 PRESIDENT'S CUP

DAWGS TAKE CARE OF UNFINISHED BUSINESS, WIN FIRST PRESIDENT'S CUP

AFTER A FOURTH-PLACE REGULAR SEASON FINISH, THE DAWGS FACED EVANSVILLE IN THE FIRST ROUND. A 4-2 WIN ON THE ROAD IN GAME ONE WAS FOLLOWED BY A 4-0 GAME TWO SHUTOUT WIN BY ROUDEBUSH AS ROANOKE SWEEP THE SERIES. THE SEMIFINALS SET A REMATCH OF THE 2022 FINAL AGAINST THE TOP-SEEDED PEORIA RIVERMEN, AND ROANOKE WON GAME ONE 3-2 AT HOME. 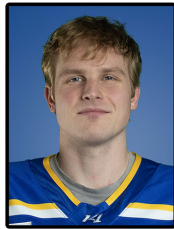

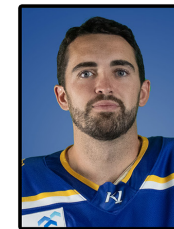

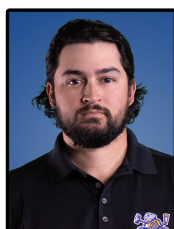
