## DAWGS NEWS AND NOTES DAWGS ROUT BULLS IN GAME ONE

THE DAWGS TRAVELED TO THE PELHAM CIVIC COMPLEX ON THURSDAY AND BLEW OUT THE BIRMINGHAM BULLS IN GAME 1 OF THE FIRST ROUND OF THE 2026 SPHL PRESIDENT'S CUP PLAYOFFS. BEHIND SIX DIFFERENT GOAL SCORERS AND 11 TOTAL POINT-GETTERS, THE DAWGS EARNED A 7-1 VICTORY IN PELHAM. GUSTAV MÜLLER RECORDED FOUR POINTS, TYING CJ STUBBS' RECORD FOR MOST POINTS IN A POSTSEASON GAME, SET IN 2024 DURING A FIRST-ROUND MATCHUP AGAINST QUAD CITY. KRISTIAN ACOSTA ALSO TALLIED THREE ASSISTS, WHILE TRAVIS BROUGHMAN ADDED A GOAL AND TWO ASSISTS.

### JOE WIDMAR STANDS ALONE

JOE WIDMAR CEMENTED HIMSELF IN DAWGS HISTORY THIS SEASON. THE FORWARD BROKE NICK FORD'S FRANCHISE RECORD FOR MOST POINTS IN A SINGLE SEASON, FINISHING WITH 77. WIDMAR ALSO ASSISTED ON MÜLLER'S OVERTIME WINNER ON SATURDAY AT PEORIA FOR HIS 49TH ASSIST, TYING FORD'S SINGLE-SEASON ASSISTS RECORD. HE FINISHED JUST ONE GOAL SHY OF TYING MAC JANSEN'S FRANCHISE GOAL MARK, ENDING THE YEAR WITH 28 GOALS. THE 31-YEAR-OLD FROM NORTHBROOK, ILLINOIS, LED THE SPHL IN BOTH POINTS AND ASSISTS WHILE RANKING FOURTH IN GOALS.

### SERIES HISTORY WITH BULLS

DATING BACK TO THE 2023 PRESIDENT'S CUP FINALS, 13 OF THE LAST 21 MEETINGS BETWEEN THESE TEAMS HAVE BEEN DECIDED BY ONE GOAL, WITH 10 GOING BEYOND REGULATION. THIS SEASON, THREE OF THE SIX MATCHUPS HAVE GONE PAST REGULATION, WITH BIRMINGHAM WINNING ALL THREE. THURSDAY NIGHT'S 7-1 VICTORY MARKED THE MOST GOALS THE DAWGS HAVE EVER SCORED AGAINST BIRMINGHAM IN A GAME IN FRANCHISE HISTORY. ADDITIONALLY, THE SIX-GOAL MARGIN MARKED THE LARGEST MARGIN OF VICTORY BY EITHER SIDE IN THE 45-GAME SERIES HISTORY. ROANOKE WILL TRY TO BUILD OFF THAT OFFENSIVE OUTBURST AND CLINCH A SPOT IN THE SPHL PRESIDENT'S CUP SEMIFINALS WITH A WIN HERE TONIGHT.

## BULLS NEWS AND NOTES

### BIRMINGHAM IN THE POSTSEASON

SINCE JOINING THE SPHL RANKS IN 2017, THE BULLS HAVE MADE FOUR PRESIDENT'S CUP PLAYOFF APPEARANCES BUT HAVE YET TO WIN THE CUP. BIRMINGHAM HAS ADVANCED PAST THE FIRST ROUND IN THREE OF THOSE FOUR POSTSEASON APPEARANCES AND HAS REACHED THE FINALS TWICE, FALLING TO ROANOKE IN 2023 AND HUNTSVILLE IN 2019. LAST SEASON, BIRMINGHAM DEFEATED FAYETTEVILLE TWO GAMES TO NONE IN THE FIRST ROUND BEFORE BEING BOUNCED BY KNOXVILLE IN THREE GAMES IN THE SEMIFINALS. THE BULLS TOOK GAME 1 AGAINST THE ICE BEARS IN KNOXVILLE BEFORE FALLING IN GAMES 2 AND 3 AT THEIR HOME BARN, THE PELHAM CIVIC COMPLEX. IN BIRMINGHAM'S FIVE POSTSEASON GAMES LAST SEASON, ROAD TEAMS WENT 4-1-0.

### GLOVER A POWER PLAY MACHINE

ON MARCH 13, DRAKE GLOVER NETTED FOUR GOALS AGAINST THE DAWGS INCLUDING A TRIO OF HAT TRICK GOALS. ON THE SEASON, THE FORWARD HAS 30 GOALS AND 15 OF WHICH COMING ON THE POWER PLAY. 50% OF HIS GOALS THIS SEASON HAVE COME FROM THE MAN ADVANTAGE AND THOSE 15 POWER PLAY GOALS ARE TIED FOR THE 14TH MOST IN A SINGLE SEASON IN LEAGUE HISTORY. IN HIS CAREER, GLOVER HAS CONVERTED ON 36 POWER PLAY GOALS WHICH IS 15TH ALL-TIME IN SPHL HISTORY. NOW IN HIS SIXTH SPHL SEASON, GLOVER IS ONE OF JUST FOUR ACTIVE PLAYERS WITH MORE THAN 100 CAREER GOALS IN THE LEAGUE, JOINING JOSH HARRIS, JORDAN ERNST, AND ALEC BAER. GLOVER'S 215 CAREER POINTS RANK FOURTH AMONG ACTIVE SPHL PLAYERS, TRAILING ONLY BAER, HARRIS, AND ROANOKE'S JOE WIDMAR. WITH MORE THAN 240 GAMES PLAYED IN HIS PROFESSIONAL CAREER, GLOVER IS SET TO FACE THE DAWGS FOR THE 46TH TIME TONIGHT.

### STEWART BACK BETWEEN THE PIPES

THE 2023-24 SPHL GOALTENDER OF THE YEAR, HAYDEN STEWART, IS BACK FOR ANOTHER SEASON WITH BIRMINGHAM, THOUGH IT HAS BEEN A ROCKY CAMPAIGN FOR THE BULLS' NETMINDER. ENTERING THE POSTSEASON, STEWART HOLDS A 11-15-4 RECORD WITH A .909 SAVE PERCENTAGE. BOTH MARKS REPRESENT THE FIRST TIME SINCE THE 2021-22 SEASON THAT STEWART HAS CARRIED A GOALS-AGAINST AVERAGE ABOVE 3.00 AND A LOSING RECORD. DESPITE THE STRUGGLES THIS SEASON, THE EIGHT-YEAR SPHL VETERAN OWNS A REMARKABLE 101-79-37 CAREER RECORD. HIS 214 CAREER GAMES PLAYED RANK THIRD ALL-TIME IN SPHL HISTORY, TRAILING ONLY AUSTYN ROUDEBUSH (226) AND PETER DI SALVO (224). STEWART ALSO BECAME JUST THE FOURTH GOALTENDER IN LEAGUE HISTORY TO REACH 100 CAREER VICTORIES, JOINING ROUDEBUSH, DI SALVO, AND CHAD COLLINS. OTHER MILESTONES ARE ALSO WITHIN REACH. STEWART'S 79 CAREER LOSSES ARE THE MOST BY ANY GOALTENDER IN SPHL HISTORY, AND HIS 5,936 SAVES RANK SECOND ALL-TIME, TRAILING ONLY DI SALVO.

## PLAYOFF SERIES HISTORY

### 2018 PRESIDENT'S CUP

#### DAWGS SWEEP BY TOP-SEEDED RIVERMEN

THE FIRST-EVER PLAYOFF GAME IN FRANCHISE HISTORY TOOK PLACE AT THE LAHAYE CENTER IN LYNCHBURG, AS ROANOKE FELL 3-2 TO PEORIA. ON LESS THAN A 48-HOUR TURNAROUND, ROANOKE DROPPED GAME TWO TO THE RIVERMEN 4-1.

### 2019 PRESIDENT'S CUP

#### DAWGS ACCEPT PEORIA CHALLENGE, THEN EGED IN SEMIS BY BULLS

IN THE CHALLENGE ROUND, TOP-SEEDED PEORIA CHOSE FIFTH-PLACE ROANOKE INSTEAD OF THE THREE LOWER-RANKED TEAMS THAT THE RIVERMEN COULD HAVE PLAYED. THE DAWGS TOOK DOWN PEORIA 4-3 AT HOME IN GAME ONE. GAME TWO SAW ROANOKE LEAP OUT TO A 4-0 LEAD, AND THE DAWGS HELD ON DESPITE EIGHT POWER PLAY CHANCES BY THE RIVERMEN TO SWEEP THE SERIES WITH A 4-3 VICTORY. THAT TOOK ROANOKE TO THE SEMIFINALS TO FACE BIRMINGHAM, WHERE THE DAWGS SPLIT THE FIRST TWO GAMES BEFORE FALLING 6-4 IN THE DECISIVE GAME THREE.

### 2022 PRESIDENT'S CUP

#### DIRTY DAWGS MAKE CINDERELLA RUN, LOSE IN FIRST FINALS APPEARANCE

ROANOKE ENTERED THE PLAYOFFS AS THE EIGHTH SEED., TAKING ON A KNOXVILLE TEAM THAT SET A NEW LEAGUE RECORD FOR WINS ON THE YEAR. ROANOKE BOUNCED BACK FROM A 4-1 GAME ONE ROAD LOSS TO TIE THE SERIES IN A 5-1 GAME TWO BLOWOUT AT HOME. ON EASTER SUNDAY, THE DAWGS SCORED TWICE IN THE FIRST FIVE MINUTES, AND HELD ON FOR A 3-1 WIN THAT UPSET THE TOP-SEEDED ICE BEARS. ROANOKE FACED SECOND-SEEDED HUNTSVILLE IN THE SEMIFINALS, AND STORMED PAST THE HAVOC 5-3 IN GAME ONE. A 36-SAVE SHUTOUT BY AUSTYN ROUDEBUSH IN GAME TWO LED ROANOKE TO A 2-0 WIN TO SWEEP THE SERIES. IN THE FINAL AGAINST THE PEORIA RIVERMEN, THE DAWGS LOST GAMES ONE AND TWO ON THE ROAD BEFORE EXTENDING THE SERIES WITH A 4-3 GAME THREE WIN AT HOME, BUT PEORIA WON THE TITLE 3-2 IN OVERTIME IN GAME FOUR.

### 2023 PRESIDENT'S CUP

#### DAWGS TAKE CARE OF UNFINISHED BUSINESS, WIN FIRST PRESIDENT'S CUP

AFTER A FOURTH-PLACE REGULAR SEASON FINISH, THE DAWGS FACED EVANSVILLE IN THE FIRST ROUND. A 4-2 WIN ON THE ROAD IN GAME ONE WAS FOLLOWED BY A 4-0 GAME TWO SHUTOUT WIN BY ROUDEBUSH AS ROANOKE SWEEP THE SERIES. THE SEMIFINALS SET A REMATCH OF THE 2022 FINAL AGAINST THE TOP-SEEDED PEORIA RIVERMEN, AND ROANOKE WON GAME ONE 3-2 AT HOME. AFTER FALLING 5-3 AT PEORIA IN GAME TWO, THE DAWGS ROARED OUT TO A 3-0 FIRST PERIOD LEAD AND HELD ON FOR A 5-3 WIN TO GET BACK TO THE FINAL, WITH NICK DEVITO TALLYING FIVE GOALS IN GAMES TWO & THREE COMBINED. IN THE FINAL AGAINST BIRMINGHAM, THE DAWGS WOULD SPLIT THE FIRST TWO ROAD GAMES IN ALABAMA WITH A 4-2 WIN AND A 2-0 SHUTOUT LOSS. GAME THREE IN ROANOKE SAW A BACK-AND-FORTH GAME GO TO OVERTIME. FOANOKE SECURED A 5-4 WIN IN OT TO TAKE THE SERIES LEAD. THE NEXT NIGHT, THE BULLS TO TIED THE GAME WITH 10.1 SECONDS LEFT IN REGULATION AT 1-1. CAPTAIN MAC JANSEN NOTCHED THE OT GAME-WINNING GOAL, AS THE DAWGS WON THEIR FIRST PRESIDENT'S CUP WITH A 2-1 WIN IN GAME FOUR. ROUDEBUSH WON PRESIDENT'S CUP MVP, DEVITO LED THE SPHL IN THE POSTSEASON IN GOALS & POINTS, AND STEPHEN ALVO DID THE SAME FOR ASSISTS.

### 2024 PRESIDENT'S CUP

#### DAWGS MAKE FOURTH STRAIGHT SEMIS, FALL TO HAVOC IN TITLE DEFENSE

TRYING TO DEFEND THEIR TITLE, THE THIRD-SEEDED DAWGS WERE NEARLY SWEEP BY SIXTH-SEEDED QUAD CITY. AFTER A 3-2 OT LOSS ON THE ROAD TO THE STORM, ROANOKE NEEDED TWO GOALS IN THE FINAL SIX MINUTES OF GAME TWO TO WIN 3-2. A 7-1 BLOWOUT BY ROANOKE IN GAME THREE PUSHED THE DAWGS BACK TO THE SEMIFINALS AGAINST FIFTH-SEEDED HUNTSVILLE. THE HAVOC WON GAME ONE 5-2 AND ROANOKE WON GAME TWO 5-4, BUT THE HAVOC ELIMINATED THE DAWGS 3-1 IN GAME THREE.
