## DAWGS NEWS AND NOTES

### DAWGS FALL IN THIRD PERIOD IN GAME THREE

THE DAWGS AND THUNDERBOLTS ENTERED THE THIRD PERIOD WEDNESDAY NIGHT TIED 1-1. HOWEVER, A LATE POWER-PLAY GOAL BY EVANSVILLE, FOLLOWED BY TWO EMPTY-NET GOALS, LIFTED THE THUNDERBOLTS TO A 4-1 VICTORY IN GAME 3. GUSTAV MÜLLER SCORED ROANOKE'S LONE GOAL ON THE POWER PLAY IN THE SECOND PERIOD, MARKING THE DAWGS' THIRD POWER-PLAY TALLY IN THE LAST TWO GAMES. SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYED A KEY ROLE, AS ALL THREE OF THE NON-EMPTY-NET GOALS IN THE CONTEST CAME ON THE MAN ADVANTAGE.

### O'DEA TIES RECORD FOR PLAYOFF GAMES PLAYED

DEFENSEMAN MATT O'DEA WILL APPEAR IN HIS 32ND CAREER POSTSEASON GAME WITH THE RAIL YARD DAWGS, TYING MAC JANSEN FOR THE MOST GAMES PLAYED BY A DAWGS PLAYER IN THE PRESIDENT'S CUP PLAYOFFS. O'DEA RECORDED AN ASSIST IN GAME 3, GIVING HIM 15 CAREER POSTSEASON HELPERS AND 19 TOTAL PLAYOFF POINTS. BOTH TOTALS RANK AMONG THE TOP THREE IN FRANCHISE HISTORY. HE NEEDS ONE MORE POINT TO TIE JANSEN'S RECORD FOR MOST CAREER POSTSEASON POINTS. O'DEA ALSO RANKS THIRD ALL-TIME IN DAWGS HISTORY IN PLAYOFF POINTS, TRAILING ONLY JANSEN AND NICK FORD.

### DAWGS FACE ELIMINATION

ROANOKE TRAILS THE BEST-OF-FIVE SERIES, TWO GAMES TO ONE, WITH THEIR BACKS AGAINST THE WALL, THE DAWGS ARE NO STRANGERS TO ELIMINATION SCENARIOS. SINCE JOINING THE SPHL IN THE 2016-17 SEASON, ROANOKE IS 8-5 ALL-TIME IN PRESIDENT'S CUP PLAYOFF ELIMINATION GAMES. SINCE THE 2022 POSTSEASON, THE DAWGS HAVE GONE 6-3 IN SUCH SITUATIONS, REPEATEDLY RISING TO THE OCCASION. IN 2024, ROANOKE DROPPED GAME 1 TO QUAD CITY IN THE OPENING ROUND BEFORE BOUNCING BACK WITH WINS IN GAMES 2 AND 3 TO ADVANCE. A SIMILAR STORY UNFOLDED IN 2022, WHEN THE DAWGS LOST THE SERIES OPENER AGAINST KNOXVILLE BUT RESPONDED WITH CONSECUTIVE VICTORIES TO MOVE ON.

## THUNDERBOLTS NEWS AND NOTES

### THE CHAMPIONS LOOK TO DEFEND THEIR TITLE

LAST SEASON, THE EVANSVILLE THUNDERBOLTS HOISTED THE PRESIDENT'S CUP FOR THE FIRST TIME IN FRANCHISE HISTORY. DESPITE ENTERING THE POSTSEASON AS THE NO. 7 SEED, EVANSVILLE WENT 6-0-1, DEFEATING HUNTSVILLE IN ROUND 1 BEFORE SWEEPING TOP-SEEDED PEORIA AND SIXTH-SEEDED KNOXVILLE TO CLAIM THE TITLE. OVER THE LAST THREE PRESIDENT'S CUP PLAYOFFS, ALL FEATURING SEMIFINAL APPEARANCES, THE THUNDERBOLTS ARE 10-4-1. OF THE 20 PLAYERS ON LAST SEASON'S POSTSEASON ROSTER, 10 RETURN FOR THIS YEAR'S RUN, INCLUDING ISAAC CHAPMAN, JORDAN SIMONEAU, MATTHEW HOBBS, TYSON GILMOUR, ETHAN LUND, MYLES ABBATE, JOEY BERKOPEC, CAMERON MACPHEE, CODY KARPINSKI, KRISTIAN STEAD, AIDEN MACINTOSH, CALEB HUFFMAN, DEREK CONTESSA, AARON HUFFNAGLE AND SCOTT KIRTON. ADDITIONALLY, THESE TWO TEAMS MET IN THE 2023 PRESIDENT'S CUP PLAYOFFS FIRST ROUND, AND HOBBS, HUFFNAGLE AND KIRTON WERE PART OF THAT MATCHUP, AND ARE SET TO FACE ROANOKE ONCE AGAIN IN 2026.

### FIRST ROUND COMEBACK HEROICS

EVANSVILLE ENTERS THE SEMIFINALS WITH SERIOUS MOMENTUM AFTER A DRAMATIC 4-3 OVERTIME WIN TO CLINCH THEIR OPENING-ROUND SERIES. THE THUNDERBOLTS TRAILED 1-0 ENTERING THE THIRD AND LATER FACED A 3-1 DEFICIT, BUT RESPONDED WITH TWO GOALS IN A 30-SECOND SPAN LATE IN REGULATION TO FORCE OVERTIME. ISAAC CHAPMAN DELIVERED THE SERIES-CLINCHING GOAL IN OVERTIME, WHILE KRISTIAN STEAD WAS STRONG IN NET WITH 32 SAVES. THE COMEBACK MARKED EVANSVILLE'S FIRST WIN ALL SEASON WHEN TRAILING AFTER TWO PERIODS, SNAPPING A 19-GAME DROUGHT. OFFENSIVELY, MULTIPLE PLAYERS CONTRIBUTED, WITH CALEB HUFFMAN LEADING THE WAY WITH A GOAL AND AN ASSIST.

### THIRD-PERIOD BOLTS

SO FAR THIS POSTSEASON, THE EVANSVILLE THUNDERBOLTS HAVE LIVED AND DIED BY THEIR THIRD-PERIOD PERFORMANCE. ENTERING GAME FOUR TONIGHT, EVANSVILLE HAS SCORED 19 GOALS IN SIX POSTSEASON GAMES, WITH 12 OF THOSE COMING IN THE THIRD PERIOD, ACCOUNTING FOR 64% OF ITS TOTAL OFFENSE DURING THE PRESIDENT'S CUP PLAYOFFS. IN THIS SEMIFINAL SERIES WITH ROANOKE, THE THUNDERBOLTS HAVE SCORED MULTIPLE THIRD-PERIOD GOALS IN ALL THREE GAMES, TOTALING EIGHT OF THEIR 10 GOALS IN THE FINAL 20 MINUTES. EVANSVILLE HAS ALSO CAPITALIZED ON THE POWER PLAY, RECORDING AT LEAST ONE POWER-PLAY GOAL IN EACH GAME OF THE SERIES. WITH TWO GOALS ON FRIDAY, ONE ON SATURDAY AND TWO MORE IN GAME THREE LAST NIGHT, THE THUNDERBOLTS ARE 5-FOR-15 (33%) WITH THE MAN ADVANTAGE IN THE SEMIFINAL SERIES.

## PLAYOFF SERIES HISTORY

### 2018 PRESIDENT'S CUP

#### DAWGS SWEEP BY TOP-SEEDED RIVERMEN

THE FIRST-EVER PLAYOFF GAME IN FRANCHISE HISTORY TOOK PLACE AT THE LAHAYE CENTER IN LYNCHBURG, AS ROANOKE FELL 3-2 TO PEORIA. ON LESS THAN A 48-HOUR TURNAROUND, ROANOKE DROPPED GAME TWO TO THE RIVERMEN 4-1.

### 2019 PRESIDENT'S CUP

#### DAWGS ACCEPT PEORIA CHALLENGE, THEN EDGED IN SEMIS BY BULLS

IN THE CHALLENGE ROUND, TOP-SEEDED PEORIA CHOSE FIFTH-PLACE ROANOKE INSTEAD OF THE THREE LOWER-RANKED TEAMS THAT THE RIVERMEN COULD HAVE PLAYED. THE DAWGS TOOK DOWN PEORIA 4-3 AT HOME IN GAME ONE. GAME TWO SAW ROANOKE LEAP OUT TO A 4-0 LEAD, AND THE DAWGS HELD ON DESPITE EIGHT POWER PLAY CHANCES BY THE RIVERMEN TO SWEEP THE SERIES WITH A 4-3 VICTORY. THAT TOOK ROANOKE TO THE SEMIFINALS TO FACE BIRMINGHAM, WHERE THE DAWGS SPLIT THE FIRST TWO GAMES BEFORE FALLING 6-4 IN THE DECISIVE GAME THREE.

### 2022 PRESIDENT'S CUP

#### DIRTY DAWGS MAKE CINDERELLA RUN, LOSE IN FIRST FINALS APPEARANCE

ROANOKE ENTERED THE PLAYOFFS AS THE EIGHTH SEED., TAKING ON A KNOXVILLE TEAM THAT SET A NEW LEAGUE RECORD FOR WINS ON THE YEAR. ROANOKE BOUNCED BACK FROM A 4-1 GAME ONE ROAD LOSS TO TIE THE SERIES IN A 5-1 GAME TWO BLOWOUT AT HOME. AFTER A FOURTH-PLACE REGULAR SEASON FINISH, THE DAWGS FACED EVANSVILLE IN THE FIRST ROUND. A 4-2 WIN ON THE ROAD IN GAME ONE WAS FOLLOWED BY A 4-0 GAME TWO SHUTOUT WIN BY ROUDEBUSH AS ROANOKE SWEEP THE SERIES. THE SEMIFINALS SET A REMATCH OF THE 2022 FINAL AGAINST THE TOP-SEEDED PEORIA RIVERMEN, AND ROANOKE WON GAME ONE 3-2 AT HOME. AFTER FALLING 5-3 AT PEORIA IN GAME TWO, THE DAWGS ROARED OUT TO A 3-0 FIRST PERIOD LEAD AND HELD ON FOR A 5-3 WIN TO GET BACK TO THE FINAL, WITH NICK DEVITO TALLYING FIVE GOALS IN GAMES TWO & THREE COMBINED. IN THE FINAL AGAINST BIRMINGHAM, THE DAWGS WOULD SPLIT THE FIRST TWO ROAD GAMES IN ALABAMA WITH A 4-2 WIN AND A 2-0 SHUTOUT LOSS. GAME THREE IN ROANOKE SAW A BACK-AND-FORTH GAME GO TO OVERTIME. ROANOKE SECURED A 5-4 WIN IN OT TO TAKE THE SERIES LEAD. THE NEXT NIGHT, THE BULLS TO TIED THE GAME WITH 10.1 SECONDS LEFT IN REGULATION AT 1-1. CAPTAIN MAC JANSEN NOTCHED THE OT GAME-WINNING GOAL, AS THE DAWGS WON THEIR FIRST PRESIDENT'S CUP WITH A 2-1 WIN IN GAME FOUR. ROUDEBUSH WON PRESIDENT'S CUP MVP, DEVITO LED THE SPHL IN THE POSTSEASON IN GOALS & POINTS, AND STEPHEN ALVO DID THE SAME FOR ASSISTS.
